james midgley provides a broad overview of social welfare outlining key institutions terminology historical research and approaches he also details reasons for the existence of international social welfare and the challenges that arise from it the author includes an important section on applied international social welfare that addresses the concerns of practitioners concerns that have been neglected in much of the literature in

the field an entire section of the book is devoted to issues of social work practice social development the activities of international agencies and their collaborative efforts while practical application is an important focus of the book several chapters deal with key theoretical debates in the field the author also includes descriptive chapters that provide comprehensive accounts of world social conditions and social welfare institutions as a textbook on international social welfare social welfare in global context is primarily intended for students and practitioners of social work social administration and social policy but it is also relevant for students of sociology public policy and economics

this book makes the case for the welfare state nearly every government in the developed world offers some form of social protection and measures to improve the social and economic well being of its citizens however the provision of welfare is under attack the critics argue that welfare states are illegitimate that things are best left to the market and that welfare has bad effects on the people who receive it if we need to be reminded why we ought to have welfare it is because so many people have come think that we should not arguments for welfare is a short accessible guide to the arguments looking at the common ideas and reoccurring traits of welfare policy across the world it discusses the meaning of the welfare state the moral basis of social policy social responsibility the limits of markets public service provision the role of government with examples from around the world the book explains why social welfare services should be provided and explores how the principles are applied most importantly it argues for the welfare state s continued value to society arguments for welfare is an ideal primer for practitioners keen to get to grips with the fundamentals of social policy and students of social policy social work sociology and politics

aims to review the issues raised by the state provision of social benefits and to examine the principles on which their provision may be deemed to rest

in recent years major social forces such as ageing populations social trends migration patterns and the globalization of economies have reshaped social welfare policies and practices across the globe multinational corporations ngos and other international organizations have begun to influence social policy at a national and local level among the many ramifications of these changes is that globalizing influences may hinder the ability of individual nation states to effect policies that are beneficial to them on a local level with contributions from thirteen countries worldwide this collected work represents the first major comparative analysis on the effect of globalization on the international

welfare state the welfare state in post industrial society is divided into two major sections the first draws from a number of leading social welfare researchers from diverse countries who point to the nation state as case studies highlighting how it goes about establishing and revising social welfare provisions the second portion of the volume then moves to a more global perspective in its analysis and questioning of the impact of globalization on citizenship ageing and marketization the welfare state in post industrial society seeks to encourage debate about the implications of the most pressing social welfare issues in nation states and integrate analyses of policy and practice in particular countries struggling to provide social welfare support for their needy populations

an analysis of social welfare institutions in the us compared with those of mexico poland and sweden the book is structured around a series of questions such as what is social welfare why do we need it and why is it controversial social welfare report card details each of the nations capacity for support for social welfare and compares the child health education and well being of the general population

after the cuts and privatisation schemes of the past decade the welfare state faces new challenges in the 1990s writers on the collectivist left the individualistic right and from schools of feminist thought claim that the state can no longer function as chief provider of welfare services it is argued that changes in the economy in the social structure and in patterns of political ideology are bringing the era of state welfare to an end in particular growing inequality coupled with rising living standards enhances many people s ability to pay for their own welfare services and undermines the sense of citizenship on which common provision must rely social change social welfare and social science provides a critical assessment of these claims and of the sociological and normative theories used to support them it argues that the case against the welfare state is not proven and explores the reasons why social science in the 1980s and 1990s has devalued state welfare as yesterday s future the book goes on to demonstrate that a forceful case for the welfare state can be made and that this must include the advancement of women s interests as an essential component in citizenship in presenting this evaluation of the theoretical empirical and philosophical arguments about the role of the state in welfare provision social change social welfare and social science is essential reading for students and researchers of social policy and the sociology and politics of welfare and also of interest to social workers health professionals and civil servants

in india in the second half of the twentieth century there was a vastly increased concern for the welfare of children various developmental programs were undertaken for the improvement of children s status especially in rural families this book first published in

1979 examines these programs and considers the enormous challenge of child care under the wide variety of conditions in this vast country

changes in ideas about social welfare have required caring professions to adapt their practices in ways which have challenged their underlying values and their relationships with service users focusing on nursing remedial therapy and social work this book examines core social values expressed through policy the implications of these ideas for the caring professions in social welfare are explored as are important questions about the use of industrial and commercial metaphors in health and human services

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
