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during the past decade significant changes have affected the world economy forcing businesses to adapt to a new world the world of the global economy this book provides managers with a guide to mastering the world of global business

global mindsets seeks to tackle a topic that is relatively new in research and practice and is considered by many to be critical for firms seeking to conduct global business it argues that multiple mindsets exist across and within organizations that they operate in a global context and that they are dynamic and undergo change and action part of the mindset s may depend upon place situation and context where individuals and organizations operate the book examines the notion of mindset is situational and dynamic especially in a global setting why it is important for future scholars and managers and how it could be conceptualized the book includes conceptual chapters that push the current boundaries of research on the topic and empirical chapters that demonstrate how different organizations in different countries apply mindset perspectives in their management practices it seeks to help academics consultants and researchers understand what has been said and studied about global mindsets in action and gain insights into possible directions and challenges that the field may face in the future

the book addresses managerial attitudes regarding globalization and international business often referred to as a global mindset a global mindset is not enabling managers to be most effective in all situations alongside the structure and culture of their working environment this leads to consequences for both managers and their organization

able to act adequately in different cultural contexts and to understand the complexities of a globalized world this means that they need to have a specific set of attitudes qualities and abilities at their disposal this set is termed a global mindset this master s thesis with the title development and outline of an assessment center for testing the global mindset investigates how properties pertaining to a global mindset can be tested by means of an assessment center to this end the thesis first discusses the concept and the background of the assessment center in particular its definition its history the persons participating in it the elements of an assessment center its areas of application and the evaluative criteria used in assessment centers in a second step the thesis discusses the concept of the global mindset subsequently the literature on using assessment centers to test the global mindset is surveyed the thesis then discusses the methodology for a qualitative empirical study which was conducted by the researcher and on which the design of an assessment center for testing the global mindset is based in the above mentioned methods section qualitative and quantitative approaches the expert interview and grounded theory are explained to give a rationale for this thesis s use of the expert interview as an instrument appropriate for exploratory investigations such as the one at hand the empirical results are presented and discussed and on their basis a concept for an assessment center is developed the concept includes the design of concrete tasks for testing qualities and abilities such as an interest in other cultures self confidence willingness to accept risk optimism self assertiveness communicative skills team spirit understanding of global interrelations and willingness to learn the thesis concludes with a comparison between the findings of previous literature and the results gained here and points out the implications of its results for both future research and practical application in a business context

this thesis involved a three year multi phased research project eighteen in depth field interviews in thirteen different mncs were first used as preliminary largely inductive observations for defining the research objectives and developing insights that are related to this study s areas of enquiry the second stage of the thesis involved a cross national survey of 136 mncs with head offices in six different countries usa canada france germany united kingdom and japan principal component analysis cluster analysis and multivariate regression analysis techniques were used to test the research hypotheses the third stage of the dissertation involved semi structured post test interviews with ten senior executives in nine different mncs

university language english abstract the purpose of this thesis is to develop suitable training measures for the area of global mindset development in the field of psychological capital by eliciting the experiences of german managers fundamentally the analysis is based on the individual level of global mindset the new theoretical lens from psychological capital is employed to gain new insights into further development of a global mindset through a qualitative research approach the qualitative approach is implemented through in depth interviews of 10 german managers with several years of management experience from major established companies the results are that the training of psyicap has to be on the emotional level also the generation of the people has an influence on the training another important and new finding is that the self reflection and individualizing of an individual promotes the sustainability process of psychological capital
