impact of the redesign of principal certification testing on principal  
preparation programs a multiple instrumental case study was conducted  
through in depth semi structured interviews with the former executive director  
of the texas council of professions of educational administration tcpea and  
administrators program coordinators of three principal certification  
programs housed in graduate schools at accredited universities in texas the  
data were analyzed for themes and reported with a narrative description the  
results of this study will contribute to the knowledge base for the redesign of  
principal certification programs and could be helpful to other institutions as  
they continue to work to refine their programs the results of the study showed  
the program narrowed educators focus to the instructional leadership and  
skills an entry level principal will need course assignments were changed to

include performance assessment for school leaders past like tasks as well as pillar assignments barriers to meeting the texas sbec requirements and implementing with fidelity included personnel resources communication and certification testing
