this is the first modern biography of the brothers grimm first published in 1970 it is a study of them in their background of late eighteenth century and nineteenth century germany and shows the position they held in their society as founders of germanic philology as members of the göttingen seven and inside the circle of the german romantics jacob and wilhelm grimm were pioneers in the
