health planning is a critical component when responding to the health needs of low and middle income countries characterised by particularly stringent resource constraints the major communicable diseases such as aids tb and malaria often appear in parallel with growing non communicable diseases including heart disease and diabetes and yet resources are often less than the levels recommended by the world health organisation for basic health care the new edition of this well respected text explains the importance of health planning in both developing regions such as africa and those in transition such as central and eastern europe it stresses the importance of understanding the national and international context in which planning occurs and provides an up to date analysis of the major current policy issues including health reforms separate chapters are dedicated to the distinct issues of finance for health care and humanresource planning the various techniques used at each stage of the planning process are explained starting with the situational analysis and then looking in turn at priority setting option appraisal programming implementation monitoring and evaluation the book ends by examining the challengesfacing planners in the 21st century particularly in the light of growing globalisation a major theme of the book is the need to recognise and reconcile the inevitable tension that lies between value judgements and rational decision making as such in addition to

introducing techniques such as costing and economic appraisal it also outlines techniques such as stakeholder analysis for understanding the relative attitudes and power of different groups in planning decisions each chapter includes a comprehensive bibliography including key websites a summary and exercises to help the reader practise techniques and better understand the content the book argues that all health professionals and community groups should be involved in the planning process for it to be effective and will therefore appeal to anyone involved in planning

this edited collection first published in 1988 was the first title to bring international perspectives into the field of rural planning using a

comparative approach and a broad range of case studies including Britain, Scandinavia, the U.S.S.R. and New Zealand. The authors review the major problems faced within rural areas and policy responses to these problems. Each study deals with the political and institutional frameworks involved in the management of rural areas and the means by which policies have been implemented. With an introduction from Paul Cloke that places rural policies and plans within the context of the state, this reissue will be of great value to any students with an interest in the planning and organisation of rural communities across the world.

Planning is becoming one of the key battlegrounds for indigenous people to negotiate meaningful articulation of their sovereign territorial and political rights, reigniting the essential tension that lies at the heart of indigenous-settler relations. But what actually happens in the planning contact zone when indigenous demands for recognition of coexisting political authority over territory intersect with environmental and urban land use planning systems in settler colonial states? This book answers that question through a critical examination of planning contact zones in two settler colonial states: Victoria, Australia, and British Columbia, Canada. Comparing the experiences of four indigenous communities who are challenging and renegotiating land use planning in these places, the book breaks new ground in our understanding of contemporary indigenous land justice politics. It is the first study to grapple with what it means for planning to engage with indigenous peoples in major cities and the first of its kind to compare the underlying conditions that produce very different outcomes in urban and non-urban planning contexts. In doing so, the book exposes the costs and limits of the liberal mode of recognition as it comes to be articulated through planning, challenging the received wisdom that participation and consultation can solve conflicts of sovereignty. This book lays the theoretical, methodological, and practical groundwork for imagining what planning for coexistence might look like: a relational, decolonizing planning praxis where self-determining indigenous peoples invite settler colonial states to their planning table on their terms.

The debate around growth has been an important feature of economic planning in India since independence. This book deals with the wide range of issues related to the country's growth and development between 1951 and 2011, covering the 11 five-year plans formulated and implemented during this period, as well as in the decade after that. The author traces the changing nature of planning over time from

rigid state control on economic activities to reliance on market based planning in the time of economic reforms he has dealt with the transition from growth measures in the 1970s to the use of a mix of growth and redistribution in the 1980s and the economic reforms and liberalization measures from 1991 onwards and the inclusive growth we have seen in the twenty first century the central theme of the book is to analyse the role that planning played in maximizing the rate of economic growth and in improving the living standards of the people considering india s rapidly changing socio economic environment many of the issues around growth and development are contentious the author discusses them here with academic rigour and an insider s insight thus enabling a fair assessment

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
