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this influential work examines how enduring dispositions or traits affect the process of aging and shape each individual's life course from two well known authorities in the field the volume is grounded in a growing body of empirical evidence critically reviewing different theories of personality and adult development the authors explain the logic behind the scientific assessment of personality present a comprehensive model of trait structure and examine patterns of trait stability and change after age 30 incorporating data from ongoing cross sectional and longitudinal studies written in a clear jargon free style this book is an ideal text for advanced students and a timely reference for researchers and clinicians

how does adhd manifest itself in adult life in general the authors write hyperactivity tends to diminish with age impulsivity changes quality and attention problems remain the same although they may become more disabling as organizational demands increase the authors carefully answer the questions often posed by professionals and patients about these symptoms and other issues they describe the diagnostic interview and the use of rating scales and include examples of the scales they also provide a well balanced review of associated psychiatric conditions such as mood and anxiety disorders tourette's syndrome oppositional and conduct problems and substance abuse descriptions of all the primary approaches to treatment medication psychological therapies and environmental restructuring include vivid case examples

human development in adulthood is a comprehensive multidisciplinary overview of adult development in a number of areas both personal and societal from mental and physical health to economic and social conditions variables including race gender economic status and political and religious affiliation are considered in the discussion of such human issues as love and marital relations economic concerns including employment and living conditions violence in its various forms including crime and war aging and death the numerous illustrations chapter summaries and glossary will prove especially useful to students

this textbook provides an up to date guide to theories within psychology and sociology relevant to understanding the major life transitions within adulthood and older age and demonstrates how they can be applied in practice in doing so it offers a psychosocial approach that will equip readers to meet the combined physical psychological and social needs of those in their care in this book the impact of biological factors on adult experience is acknowledged alongside a careful exploration of the socially constructed nature of different stages of adulthood across the lifespan in its analysis of developmental stages the book covers key issues of current concern including emerging and early adulthood the sandwich generation those caring for both their children and their parents later life medicalisation neurodiversity long term and degenerative conditions bereavement and grief both vulnerabilities and ways to enhance resilience encouraging healthy ageing are examined utilising practice oriented case studies and reflective questions it illustrates how psychosocial perspectives may be applied within family workplace health and social care contexts it offers under graduate and graduate students of social work nursing mental health education psychology human development gerontology and ageing the tools needed to evaluate the interlocking psychosocial factors influencing the lives of adults at different stages of life

for some time now the study of cognitive development has been far and away the most active discipline within developmental psychology although there would be much disagreement as to the exact proportion of papers published in developmental journals that could be considered cognitive 50 seems like a conservative estimate hence a series of scholarly books devoted to work in cognitive development is especially appropriate at this time the springer series in cognitive development contains two basic types of books namely edited collections of original chapters by several authors and original volumes written by one author or a small group of authors the flagship for the springer series is a

serial publication of the advances type carrying the subtitle progress in cognitive development research each volume in the progress sequence is strongly thematic in that it is limited to some well defined domain of cognitive developmental research e g logical and mathematical development development of learning all progress volumes will be edited collections editors of such collections upon consultation with the series editor may elect to have their books published either as contributions to the progress sequence or as separate volumes all books written by one author or a small group of authors are being published as separate volumes within the series a fairly broad definition of cognitive development is being used in the selection of books for this series

this book presents data that challenges the long established view that separation anxiety disorder should be reserved for diagnosis among children and adolescents by demonstrating that adult onset is prevalent in many countries and that adult onset separation anxiety disorder is just as persistent and impairing as the pediatric onset form separation anxiety disorder in adulthood is associated with high levels of disability research and clinical data indicate that overlooking the diagnosis of adult separation anxiety disorder may result in substantial costs in the form of disability and suffering over the last decades the psychiatry school of pisa in the person of director giovanni b cassano m d and stefano pini m d has conducted seminal studies in this area and brought research data into clinical practice at the same time the pisa school has made a paramount contribution to the dsm 5 reformulation of adult separation anxiety disorder which has since been transferred to the anxiety disorders chapter barbara milrod m d is an unusual clinical investigator she has conducted clinical research in separation anxiety disorder panic disorder and post traumatic stress disorder for the past two decades she has incorporated separation anxiety constructs into her approach to mechanisms of psychotherapy research across these disorders and in affect focused psychotherapies the book consists of 10 chapters organized into two sections a general principles section and diagnosis and treatment section the first section focuses on the biological underpinnings of separation anxiety and on the historical pathways that led to its dsm 5 categorization the second elaborates on clinical topics preventive strategies and treatments this book will help the reader to understand and diagnose separation anxiety disorder and to bear it in mind during the differential diagnosis of patients of all ages presenting not only with anxiety but also with a variety of psychiatric and behavioral disorders

erik erikson 1902 1994 was one of the most eminent and prolific psychologists of the 20th century over his long career

he published a dozen books including classics such as childhood and society identity youth and crisis and young man luther he was awarded the pulitzer prize and the national book award in 1970 for his biography gandhi s truth it was also in 1970 when he retired from harvard university that erikson began to rethink his earlier theories of development he became increasingly occupied with the conflicts and challenges of adulthood a shift from his earlier writings on the identity crises of adolescence for the past twenty years carol hoare has written extensively on various aspects of erikson s work she has been aided by access to erikson s unpublished papers at harvard as well as cooperation with joan erikson the psychologist s wife and longtime collaborator by reconstructing erikson s theory of adulthood from his unpublished papers hoare provides not only a much needed revision of erikson s work but also a glimpse into the mind of one of the 20th century s most profound thinkers

this book highlights international efforts to better understand the role of individual differences in healthy aging by exploring new directions methods and questions within the field the book considers how to measure personality and personality change during adulthood the associations between personality and healthy aging outcomes over time and the role of personality in building interventions to promote healthy aging the first section considers the value of personality constructs for healthy aging outcomes beyond the broad big five personality dimensions it discusses the role of attachment purpose and affect and also touches on the issue of psychopathology the second section presents innovative assessment methods research designs beyond classical longitudinal approaches as well as sophisticated and integrative techniques for analyzing personality change processes the third section raises new important questions such as how interventionists from non personality domains can incorporate personality processes in their intervention programs it also discusses how different domains of individual functioning may interact in concert to predict healthy aging outcomes as well as how more integrative lifespan models of healthy aging may advance research on personality and healthy aging overall this book will spark interest and chart new directions for researchers practitioners and interventionists in healthy aging gerontology and applied fields
