technology the relatively backward society of medieval europe bristled with inventions and the period between the reformation and the industrial revolution was one of slow and unspectacular progress in technology despite the tumultuous developments associated with the voyages of discovery and the scientific revolution what were the causes of technological creativity mokyr distinguishes between the relationship of inventors and their physical environment which determined their willingness to challenge nature and the social environment which determined the openness to new ideas he discusses a long list of such factors showing how they interact to help or hinder a nation's creativity and then illustrates them by a number of detailed comparative studies examining the differences between europe and china between classical antiquity and medieval europe and between britain and the rest of europe during the industrial revolution he examines such aspects as the role of the state the chinese gave up a millennium wide lead in shipping to the europeans for example when an emperor banned large ocean going vessels the impact of science as well as religion politics and even nutrition he questions the importance of such commonly cited factors as the spill over benefits of war the abundance of natural resources life expectancy and labor costs today an ever greater number of industrial economies are competing in the global market locked in a struggle that revolves around technological ingenuity the lever of riches with its keen analysis derived from a sweeping survey of creativity throughout history offers telling insights into the question of how western economies can maintain and developing nations can unlock their creative potential

from the irish cailleach and other shape shifters of folk legends to modern movie transformers from ovid's metamorphoses to the moment when gregor samsa woke up one morning to find himself transformed into an insect in kafka's novella from conversion narratives to slave narratives turning points and transformations have always been central to literary works and to cultural developments in fact with freytag's pyramid in mind one could claim that all literary works focus on the trope of a transformation born of a turning point because such moments comprise the very essence and vitality of human life and culture but why are turning points necessarily transformational and in what way and what brings about those turning points in language literature culture and human lives these are essentially the questions the essays in this volume seek to answer the contributors examine turning points and transformations personal literary and cultural brought about through the randomness of the universe as well as through human interference and discuss ways in which humans in general and writers in particular through their art experience and cope with the ineluctable results
