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2025 most significant scholarly book texas institute of letters a history of racism and segregation in twentieth century houston and beyond through the 1950s and beyond the supreme court issued decisions that appeared to provide immediate civil rights protections to racial minorities as it relegated jim crow to the past for black houstonians who had been hoping and actively fighting for what they called a raceless democracy these postwar decades were often seen as decades of promise in houston and the permanence of segregation david ponton argues that these were instead decades of capture times in which people were captured and constrained by gender and race by faith in the law by antiblack violence and even by the narrative structures of conventional histories bringing the insights of black studies and afropessimism to the field of urban history ponton explores how gender roles constrained thought in black freedom movements how the rule of law compelled black houstonians to view injustice as a sign of progress and how antiblack terror undermined houston s narrative of itself as a heavenly place today houston is one of the most racially diverse cities in the united states and at the same time it remains one of the most starkly segregated ponton s study demonstrates how and why segregation has become a permanent feature in our cities and offers powerful tools for imagining the world otherwise

2022 best book award oral history association hundreds of stories of activists at the front lines of the intersecting african american and mexican american liberation struggle not one but two civil rights movements flourished in mid twentieth century texas and they did so in intimate conversation with one another far from the gaze of the national media african american and mexican american activists combated the twin caste systems of jim crow and juan crow these insurgents worked chiefly within their own racial groups yet they also looked to each other for guidance and at times came together in solidarity the movements sought more than integration and access they demanded power and justice civil rights in black and brown draws on more than 500 oral history interviews newly collected across texas from the panhandle to the piney woods and everywhere in between the testimonies speak in detail to the structure of racism in small towns and huge metropolises both the everyday grind of segregation and the haunting acts of racial violence that upheld texas s state sanctioned systems of white supremacy through their memories of resistance and revolution the activists reveal previously undocumented struggles for equity as well as the links black and chicanx organizers forged in their efforts to achieve self determination

using first person narratives collected through oral history interviews this groundbreaking book collects black women s memories of their public and private lives during the period of legal segregation in the american south

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examines why school desegregation despite its success in closing the achievement gap was never embraced wholeheartedly in the black community as a remedy for racial

inequality in 2007 a court case originally filed in louisville kentucky was argued before the supreme court and officially ended the era of school desegregation both changing how schools across america handle race and undermining the most important civil rights cases of the last century of course this wasn't the first federal lawsuit to challenge school desegregation but it was the first and only one brought by african americans in divided we fail journalist sarah garland deftly and sensitively tells the stories of the families and individuals who fought for and against desegregation by reframing how we commonly understand race education and the history of desegregation this timely and deeply relevant book will be an important contribution to the continued struggle toward true racial equality

race and place considers the everyday experiences of community members throughout the process of school desegregation and how race place and truth came to matter in this process in prince george's county maryland from 1945 through 1973 the book is organized around several successive policies that emerged in this time school equalization school choice neighborhood schools school construction school closure busing for racial integration and school discipline dougherty shows how these policies contained and reinforced assumptions about place and created new racial truths about people and schooling
