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testing of communicating systems presents the latest international results in both the theory and industrial practice of the testing of communicating systems the topics discussed range from tools and techniques for testing to test standards frameworks notations algorithms fundamentals of testing and industrial experiences and issues the tools and techniques discussed apply to conformance testing interoperability testing performance testing of communications software internet protocols and applications and multimedia and distributed systems in general such as systems for electronic commerce this volume contains the extensively refereed proceedings of the 13th international conference on testing of communicating systems testcom 2000 which was sponsored by the international federation for information processing ifip and held in ottawa ontario canada in early september 2000 testing of communicating systems is essential reading for engineers designers managers of it products and services and all researchers interested in advancing the technology of engineering internet frameworks systems services and applications for reliability and quality

the aim of this book is to bring together the research of academics and practitioners in the field of communication systems testing it covers four major topic areas types of testing including conformance testing interoperability testing performance and qos testing phases of testing including test case generation means of testing test execution and test results analysis classes of systems tested and the theory and practice of testing including test related algorithms practical testing methodology and practical testing experience

new manufacturing technologies have made possible the integration of entire systems on a single chip this new design paradigm termed system on chip soc together with its associated manufacturing problems represents a real challenge for designers soc is also reshaping approaches to test and validation activities these are beginning to migrate from the traditional register transfer or gate levels of abstraction to the system level until now test and validation have not been supported by system level design tools so designers have lacked the infrastructure to exploit all the benefits stemming from the adoption of the system level of abstraction research efforts are already addressing this issue this monograph provides a state of the art overview of the current validation and test techniques by covering all aspects of the subject including modeling of bugs and defects stimulus generation for validation and test purposes including timing errors design for testability
