

Managing Water Supply And Sanitation In Emergencies

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this is surely the most impressive and important publication to come out of the un system for many years peter adamson founder new internationalist and author and

researcher of unicef's the state of the world's children from 1980 to 1995 the world's governments agreed at the millennium summit to halve by 2015 the number of people who lack access to safe water with rapidly growing urban populations the challenge is immense water and sanitation in the world's cities is a comprehensive and authoritative assessment of the problems and how they can be addressed this influential publication by the united nations human settlements programme unhabitat sets out in detail the scale of inadequate provision of water and sanitation it describes the impacts on health and economic performance showing the potential gains of remedial action it analyses the proximate and underlying causes of poor provision and identifies information gaps affecting resource allocation it outlines the consequences of further deterioration and it explains how resources and institutional capacities public private and community can be used to deliver proper services through integrated water resource management

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this book is based on a public health approach to the provision of water and sanitation in emergencies an approach that is information based and people based it emphasizes the need for a coordinated and phased response which adapts to meet constantly changing needs

this book tries to capture 13 case studies from different states of the country covering various aspects of sanitation programme so that the district and state officials are able to draw lessons and improve the programme implementation in their districts the case studies are written by practitioners of rural sanitation i.e. district and state officials and ngos directly involved in the programme implementation they have tried to discuss the key issues and strategies to overcome

challenges citing actual case of the district state the book highlights key learning elements from these case studies which can be used by others in sanitation sector as well as other social development programmes in addition the book offers them the opportunity to learn from the existing experiences in the field and make necessary programmatic improvements

in recent years the growing disparities between rural and urban areas in developing countries have been a cause of major concern the rural urban gap remains the single most well documented development and welfare disparity in the developing world this gap can be seen in the low economic activities higher poverty levels and lower quality infrastructure and services in rural areas as opposed to urban areas while the magnitude of this rural urban divide is well documented very little has been documented about its impact on inclusive and sustainable urban development the handbook of research on managing the urban rural divide through an inclusive framework aims to capture the spatial and socio economic divide between rural and urban areas and provides a road map to revamping the discussion that surrounds the urban rural sphere covering key topics such as development food security and rural regions this premier reference source is ideal for policymakers government officials industry professionals researchers academicians practitioners scholars instructors and students

sustainable infrastructure development is vital for africa s prosperity and now is the time to begin the transformation this volume is the culmination of an unprecedented effort to document analyze and interpret the full extent of the challenge in developing sub saharan africa s infrastructure sectors as a result it represents the most comprehensive reference currently available on infrastructure in the region the book covers the five main economic infrastructure sectors information and communication technology irrigation power transport and water and sanitation africa s infrastructure a time for transformation reflects the collaboration of a wide array of african regional institutions and development partners under the auspices of the infrastructure consortium for africa it presents the findings of the africa infrastructure country diagnostic aid a project launched following a commitment in 2005 by the international community after the g8 summit at gleneagles scotland to scale up financial support for infrastructure development in africa the lack of reliable information in this area made it difficult to evaluate the success of past interventions prioritize current allocations and provide benchmarks for measuring

future progress hence the need for the aid africa s infrastructure sectors lag well behind those of the rest of the world and the gap is widening some of the main policy relevant findings highlighted in the book include the following infrastructure in the region is exceptionally expensive with tariffs being many times higher than those found elsewhere inadequate and expensive infrastructure is retarding growth by 2 percentage points each year solving the problem will cost over us 90 billion per year which is more than twice what is being spent in africa today however money alone is not the answer prudent policies wise management and sound maintenance can improve efficiency thereby stretching the infrastructure dollar there is the potential to recover an additional us 17 billion a year from within the existing infrastructure resource envelope simply by improving efficiency for example improved revenue collection and utility management could generate us 3.3 billion per year regional power trade could reduce annual costs by us 2 billion and deregulating the trucking industry could reduce freight costs by one half so raising more funds without also tackling inefficiencies would be like pouring water into a leaking bucket finally the power sector and fragile states represent particular challenges even if every efficiency in every infrastructure sector could be captured a substantial funding gap of 31 billion a year would remain nevertheless the african people and economies cannot wait any longer now is the time to begin the transformation to sustainable development

urban sanitation and solid waste sectors are under significant pressure in east africa due to the lack of competent institutional capacity and the growth of the region s urban population this book presents and applies an original analytical approach to assess the existing socio technical mixtures of waste and sanitation systems and to ensure wider access increase flexibility and ecological sustainability it shows how the problem is not the current diversity in waste and sanitation infrastructures and services and variety of types and scales of technology of formal and informal sector involvement and of management and ownership modes the book focuses instead on the lack of an integrative approach to managing and upgrading of the various waste and sanitation configurations and services so as to ensure wider access flexibility and sustainability for the low income populations who happen to be the main stakeholders this approach coined modernized mixtures serves as a nexus throughout the book the empirical core addresses the waste and sanitation challenges and debates at each scale from the micro level households to the macro level international support and is based on the results of a five year long interdisciplinary empirical research program it assesses the socio technical diversity in waste and sanitation and provides viable solutions to sanitation and waste management in east africa this book provides students researchers and professional in environmental technology sociology management and urban planning with an integrated analytical perspective on centralized and decentralized waste and sanitation configurations and tools for improvement in the technology policy and management of sanitation and solid waste sectors

this book centers around an intense debate among donors policymakers development practitioners and academics on the efficacy of aid in eradicating poverty while promoting human development it seeks to fill the gap in present literature by presenting stories of better spending through implementing sustainable development goals and addressing agenda 2030 via indigenization of global development goals with initiatives at local and national levels the book adopts an innovative approach to dealing with aid effectiveness by highlighting the relevance of better spending rather than excessive spending it does so with real life examples of interventions made in the global south to realize the vision of thinking globally and acting locally these case studies speak to the significance of communities role in shouldering responsibility for planning financing operating and maintaining local developmental initiatives the examples also demonstrate how aid serves its purpose when used as an investment in communities and enterprising individuals in order to realize the strategic impact of giving and build a local receiving mechanism for indigenizing and achieving global development goals the book references cases of better spending by governments philanthropists and civil society organizations csos from across asia africa and latin america on a range of issues and will thus be of interest to development practitioners policymakers donors philanthropists civil society organizations and academics and students of international development studies
