address this significant flaw in economic thought the book describes a relatively new transdiscipline that incorporates insights from the biological physical and social sciences it provides students with a foundation in traditional neoclassical economic thought but places that foundation within an interdisciplinary framework that embraces the linkages among economic growth environmental degradation and social inequity in doing so it presents a revolutionary way of viewing the world the second edition of ecological economics provides a clear readable and easy to understand overview of a field of study that continues to grow in importance it remains the only stand alone textbook that offers a complete explanation of theory and practice in the discipline
