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it has become clear that the u s media are no longer increasingly their grip throughout the globe asia and the arab moslem world is virtually saturated with their own national media output tunstall produces a well written provocative snapshot at global media today his point of view is relentlessly global he considers the role of the media in the collapse of the soviet union the ascendancy of the brazilian and mexican soap opera the increasing strength of bollywood the national cinema output of india as well as the relative decline in influence of us media importantly tunstall focuses on both the nation state and the geographical and cultural region as crucial levels in today s mass media both the united states and the us mass media have now lost their previous moral leadership lone american control of the world news flow has ceased today rather than global media we see a world media system comprised of interlocking national regional cultural systems tunstall s assessment is a wake up call for insular american media consumers
