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introductory statistics for management and economics is designed specifically for business economics and management majors who are enrolled in a two term statistics course the new fourth edition of this popular text continues to emphasize statistical inference and model building in a real world context it contains over 1 500 varying types of problems based on real world applications as well as in depth coverage of regression analysis and a thorough discussion of how to use the computer to estimate and test models computer applications sections have been added to help students understand and interpret statistical output new to the fourth edition new chapter on statistical quality control covers process control charts process capability and improvement hundreds of new computer exercises and problems with relevant data provided on a data disk new statistics in action segments based on how to apply statistics and streamlined coverage of probability and sampling

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this new edition has been expanded using state of the art minitab graphics to reflect current trends in descriptive data analysis much of the text has been rewritten in response to student requests to make the language and style more readable and user friendly this classic now features a more graphic approach to modernize it and more emphasis on the uses of the computer in statistics is also a focus for this edition inference making crystal clear explanations and well honed exercises with raw data sets continue to be the hallmarks for the book

the introductory statistics course presents serious pedagogical problems to the instructor for the great majority of students the course represents the only formal contact with statistical thinking that he or she will have in college students come from many different fields of study and a large number suffer from math anxiety thus an instructor who is willing to settle for some limited objectives will have a much better chance of success than an instructor who aims for a broad exposure to statistics many statisticians agree that the primary objective of the introductory statistics course is to introduce students to variability and uncertainty and how to cope with them when drawing inferences from observed data additionally the introductory course should enable students to handle a limited number of useful statistical techniques the present text which is the successor to the author's introduction to statistics a nonparametric approach houghton mifflin company boston 1976 tries to meet these objectives by introducing the student to the basic ideas of estimation and hypothesis testing early in the course after a rather brief introduction to data organization and some simple ideas about probability estimation and hypothesis testing are discussed in terms of the two sample problem which is both conceptually simpler and more realistic than the one sample problem that customarily serves as the basis for the discussion of statistical inference

using high quality real world case studies and examples this introduction to mathematical statistics shows how to use statistical methods and when to use them this book can be used as a brief introduction to design of experiments this successful calculus based book of probability and statistics was one of the first to make real world applications an integral part of motivating discussion the number of problem sets has increased in all sections some sections include almost 50 new problems while the most popular case studies remain for anyone needing to develop proficiency with mathematical statistics
