costs and benefits that exist within that area so economists are need to be train to step into an unfamiliar field will have more career and life opportunities as well as more tools to change the world human rights may include those issues such as freedom and equity right to be recognition as a person before a court of law freedom from discrimination before the law within each human right violation there are monetary and non monetaty costs when a country district attorney makes the decision to try a care as a capital crime the country is liable for the cost of the capital case so each of the violations of human rightsis the choices based in part on costs to the decision maker marginal cost is the cost of last unit produced or chosen in economic theory in human right marginal cost economic theory explanation aspect for example the number of times a person is convicted of a relatively minor illegal offence can add up to equal a relatively serious illegal offence usuallypubishable by imprisonment consequently the more times the person is caught the less chance he will have to get a good job and bad things will be needed for survival in a community the person decides to steal the marginal cost increases so in society the number of times food stolen increases than the social marginal cost of stealing food will also increases so our society needs to concern how to bring social net benefits of human rights violation it means that when the number of times food stolen reduces then the society will bring marginal benefit of reducing stealing food
