federalist solutions to pakistan s political crises investigates the transformative potential of communal democratic norms within pakistan s politico economic sphere analyzing the current consociational structure which inordinately predicates federal organization on ethnic identity the book reveals the particular challenges facing pakistan exacerbated by the imposition of neoliberal norms on its society and economy advocating for a localized centripetalist model sikander ahmed shah proposes leveraging power sharing to counter the prevailing hegemonic trends and to foster greater sociocultural cohesion within pakistan s diverse polity this model entails dividing pakistan s federal provinces into smaller diverse entities more reflective of their particular constituent demographics while integrating key democratic principles such as distributive justice grassroots democracy minority protections and multiculturalism into its governance structures the book explores pakistan s civil military asymmetry emphasizing the influential role of the military establishment and its intertwined relationship with preexisting inter ethnic tensions the analysis also extends to the china pakistan economic corridor cpec examining its impact on pakistan s federal structure socio economic fabric and civil military dynamics within the context of china s distinctive economy throughout the work seeks to provide locally relevant and indigenously viable solutions for positive and equitable outcomes challenging historical power imbalances that have marginalized certain groups in pakistan

international migration and urbanization as economic processes can provide great opportunities to solve local and regional economic and social problems and lead to the leveling of global economic unfairness and multi complexity however uncontrolled migration and urbanization can easily destroy market stability and create many new social and economic problems both in developed due to migration and developing due to urbanization countries migration and urbanization local solutions for global economic challenges is a collection of innovative research that sets basic rules and patterns for state regulation of urbanization and international migration and for increasing the economic efficiency of developed and developing countries additionally the book evaluates the economic impact of urbanization and international migration at the global national and regional levels while highlighting topics including economic security modern mechanisms

this book analyses the roots of the current housing crisis in england critically reviewing the development of policy under successive uk governments and presenting a specific critique of the current conservative government s housing and planning reforms

for over two decades many liberals in israel have attempted with wide international support to implement the two state solution israel and palestine partitioned on the basis of the green line that is the line drawn by the 1949 armistice agreements that defined israel s borders until 1967 before israel occupied the west bank and gaza following the six day war by going back to israel s pre 1967 borders many people hope to restore israel to what they imagine was its pristine pre occupation character and to provide a solid basis for a long term solution to the israeli palestinian conflict in this original and controversial essay yehouda shenhav argues that this vision is an illusion that ignores historical realities and offers no long term solution it fails to see that the real problem is that a state was created in most of palestine in 1948 in which jews are the privileged ethnic group at the expense of the palestinians who also must live under a constant state of emergency the issue will not be resolved by the two state solution which will do little for the millions of palestinian refugees and will also require the uprooting of hundreds of thousands of jews living across the green line all these obstacles require a bolder rethinking of the issues the green line should be abandoned and a new type of polity created on the complete territory of mandatory palestine with a new set of constitutional arrangements that address the rights of both palestinians and jews including the settlers

reinventing economic development as if small business mattered in cities and towns across the nation economic development is at a crossroads a growing body of evidence has proven that its current cornerstone incentives to attract and retain large globally mobile businesses is a dead end even those programs that focus on local business through buy local initiatives for example depend on ongoing support from government or philanthropy the entire practice of economic development has become ineffective and unaffordable and is in need of a makeover the local economy solution suggests an alternative approach in which states and cities nurture a new generation of special kinds of businesses that help local businesses grow these cutting edge companies which shuman calls pollinator businesses are creating jobs and the conditions for future economic growth and doing so in self financing ways pollinator

businesses are especially important to communities that are struggling to lift themselves up in a period of economic austerity when municipal budgets are being slashed they also promote locally owned businesses that increase local self reliance and evince high labor and environmental standards the book includes nearly two dozen case studies of successful pollinator businesses that are creatively facilitating business and neighborhood improvements entrepreneurship local purchasing local investing and profitable business partnerships examples include main street genome which provides invaluable data to improve local business performance supportland which is developing a powerful loyalty card for local businesses and fledge a business accelerator that finances itself through royalty payments it also shows how the right kinds of public policy can encourage the spread of pollinator businesses at virtually no cost
