gershwin began the two piano score in july titling the original drafts the new york concerto it was performed first in december 1925 with gershwin at the piano and mr damrosch conducting the new york symphony orchestra this is the 1927 2 piano score technically advanced in level of difficulty two copies are needed for performance two piano edition with second piano playing a transcription of the orchestration
