term paper i will show how the blends are classified into modified and meaningful blends and how they are categorized including the categorization of their source words i am going to answer the question how blends are structured and what kind of rules there are for their formation the term paper will answer all these questions by analyzing blends and their source words and this will show that blending is a word formation process

this volume presents two works elaborating a general theory of words and their structure written by rené de saussure younger brother of ferdinand de saussure although originating in rené de saussure s concerns for the structure of esperanto these essays are clearly intended to articulate a general account of word formation in natural language they appear here in the french original with facing english translations accompanied by some remarks on rené de saussure s life and followed by essays on the esperantist background of his analysis by marc van oostendorp the contemporary relevance of his morphological theory by stephen anderson and the semantic theory of words underlying his analysis by louis de saussure these two works have remained essentially unknown to the community of scholars in general linguistics since their publication in 1911 and 1919 respectively although esperantists have been aware of them they develop in quite explicit form a theory of what would later be called morphemic analysis based primarily on data from french with some material from german and english as well as occasional examples from other indo european languages in its fundamental aspect rené s view of word formation differed significantly from that of his brother who saw the structure of complex words as revealed not through their decomposition into smaller atomic units but rather in the relations between words relations which could be presented in analogical form and which anticipate rule based theories of morphological structure the contrast between the two brothers views thus anticipates basic issues in current theorizing about word structure

this book aims to reconcile the generative considerations of Jackendoff's parallel architecture with the European structuralist approach to naming it shows that there are good reasons to single out word formation as a separate component in PA it demonstrates that it is a drawback not to distinguish word formation and explains that the function of word formation rules is different from the function of the lexicon and rules of grammar after making the argument for a separate word formation component the book sets out to determine which types of rule qualify as part of this component traditionally the boundaries of word formation with inflection and with syntax have been a matter of debate by focusing on the naming function the book poses a guiding principle for determining which rules should be in the word formation component the position of morphology in the architecture of grammar has always been an issue of debate in generative linguistics since Chomsky 1970 this question has been framed in terms of the lexicalist hypothesis compared to Chomsky's architectures Jackendoff's parallel architecture places phonetic and conceptual structures at the same level as syntactic structure i.e. connected by bidirectional linking rules rather than interpretation rules one of the consequences is that PA does not formally distinguish lexicon entries from rules of grammar this changes the setting for the question of the autonomy of morphology because the lexicalist hypothesis depends on this distinction

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
