an up close look at the education arms race of after school learning academic competitions and the perceived failure of even our best schools to educate children beyond soccer leagues music camps and drama lessons today s youth are in an education arms race that begins in elementary school in hyper education pawan dhingra uncovers the growing world of high achievement education and the after school learning centers spelling bees and math competitions that it has spawned it is a world where immigrant families vie with other americans to be at the head of the class putting in hours of studying and testing in order to gain a foothold in the supposed meritocracy of american public education a world where enrichment centers like kumon have seen 194 percent growth since 2002 and target children as young as three even families and teachers who avoid after school academics are getting swept up drawing on over 100 in depth interviews with teachers tutors principals children and parents dhingra delves into the why people participate in this phenomenon and examines how schools families and communities play their part moving past tiger mom stereotypes he addresses why asian american and white families practice what he calls hyper education and whether or not it makes sense by taking a behind the scenes look at the scripps national spelling bee other national competitions and learning centers dhingra shows why good schools good grades and good behavior are seen as not enough for high achieving students and their parents and why the education arms race is likely to continue to expand

this book provides readers with a detailed sketch of the mandarin competence of chinese children in singapore from different home language backgrounds their mandarin competence is defined in terms of lexical diversity syntactic complexity and code switching tendency the findings presented show that there are statistical differences in lexical diversity and syntactic complexity among the compared groups of children and these differences in linguistic competence were found to be positively correlated to increased mandarin exposure at home they also demonstrate that there are statistical differences in code switching tendency among the groups of children compared which were found to be negatively correlated to increased exposure to mandarin at home a general relationship between home language exposure and mandarin competence was established although this relationship was found to be volatile especially among children who are more bilingually exposed this book shares these findings with linguists language educators

and language policymakers both local and international

number of difficult problems to solve arising not only due to the complexities in acquiring the molecular information but also due to the size and nature of the generated data sets and or the limitations of the algorithms required for analyzing these data although the field of bioinformatics is still in its embryonic stage the recent advancements in computational and information theoretic techniques are enabling us to conduct various in silico testing and screening of many lab based experiments before these are actually performed in vitro or in vivo these in silico investigations are providing new insights for interpretation and establishing a new direction for a deeper understanding among the various advanced computational methods currently being applied to such studies the pattern recognition techniques are mostly found to be at the core of the whole discovery process for apprehending the underlying biological knowledge thus we can safely surmise that the going bioinformatics revolution may in future inevitably play a major role in many aspects of medical practice and or the discipline of life sciences
