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in this timely volume m parvizi amineh brings together a multitude of studies of modern asian postcolonial states and societies this part of the world has undergone major transitions over the past decade and is quickly becoming a major player in international policy and the global economy grounded in the most recent scholarship state society and international relations in

asia covers several large scale global concerns including nationalism democratization corruption religious tension globalization and regionalization

from rap to folk to punk music has often sought to shape its listeners political views uniting them as a global community and inspiring them to take action yet the rallying potential of music can also be harnessed for sinister ends as this groundbreaking new book reveals white power music has served as a key recruiting tool for neo nazi and racist hate groups worldwide reichsrock shines a light on the international white power music industry the fandoms it has spawned and the virulently racist beliefs it perpetuates kirsten dyck not only investigates how white power bands and their fans have used the internet to spread their message globally but also considers how distinctly local white power scenes have emerged in western europe eastern europe latin america the united states and many other sites while exploring how white power bands draw from a common well of nationalist racist and neo nazi ideologies the book thus also illuminates how white power musicians adapt their music to different locations many of which have their own terms for defining whiteness and racial otherness closely tracking the online presence of white power musicians and their fans dyck analyzes the virtual forums and media they use to articulate their hateful rhetoric this book also demonstrates how this fandom has sparked spectacular violence in the real world from bombings to mass shootings reichsrock thus sounds an urgent message about a global menace

conflicts in western societies have been on the rise and not just since the financial crisis of 2008 this is generally explained in economic terms with growing disparities in wealth and income the left should benefit from this with its redistribution philosophy however the right is on the upswing even though its neoliberalism is fueling social conflicts how is that behind the economic tensions lies a deep crisis of meaning the right is exploiting this by offering simplistic set pieces of meaning with success because people strive for nothing so much as meaning in their own lives the example of the usa shows how neoliberalism destroys people and societies possible solutions also come from there

out of hiding extremist white supremacy and how it can be stopped explains how white supremacist extremism endures the varied forms it takes its relationship with systemic racism and what to do about it the book draws on more than 30 years of extensive data and direct experiences with extremists to describe how white supremacy moved into the spotlight during the first two decades of the 21st century the argument focuses on three moments between 2008 and today during which white supremacists took opportunities to move from pockets of underground activism to violent protests across the united states the authors offer a corrective to observers who mischaracterize today s racial extremism as a new form of alt right conservatism or white nationalism emanating from an isolated poorly educated and economically disenfranchised online fringe these misunderstandings reflect the limited attention given to the varied and persistent forms of racial extremism that have long simmered in america and an inability to acknowledge the appeal white supremacist messages can hold for a broad swath of the u s population this volume contributes a longer view than other books to demonstrate that today s white supremacy is less a unique eruption than a

continuation and an acceleration of longstanding u s white supremacy this is essential reading for scholars and activists interested in racism white supremacy and far right extremism

in early may 1940 the fortress of eben emael was a potent sentinel over the belgian dutch borderlands the fortress covered 75 hectares on the surface had 5km of tunnels underground and was studded with bunkers gun turrets and casemates add a garrison of 1 200 men and the natural protection of 60m high canal walls and eben emael gave the impression of near impregnability yet on 10 may just 78 elite airborne soldiers managed to defeat this fortress in an operation of unprecedented tactical skill deployed by glider onto the very top of the fortifications they utilized elite training fast movement and specialist explosives to destroy many of the gun positions and trap much of the garrison within the fortress simultaneously three other assault detachments conducted high risk glider operations to capture critical bridges over the albert canal by the end of 11 may following the arrival of german infantry reinforcements eben emael was in german hands this eben emael raid title tells the complete fascinating story of this unique action

a highly illustrated account of the hunt for the bismarck the break of the german battleship bismarck into the north atlantic in may 1941 was one of the most dramatic episodes of world war ii it began with a battle between the bismarck and the british battleship prince of wales and the heavy cruiser hood the hood was blown to pieces while the battered prince of wales managed to escape the british then focused all of their resources on hunting the mighty german battleship and eventually brought her down supported by birds eye view maps and archive photography this volume recounts the fight in detail

this interdisciplinary study examines the still vivid phenomenon of the most controversial psychiatric diagnosis in the united states multiple personality disorder now called dissociative identity disorder this syndrome comprehends the occurrence of two or more distinct identities that take control of a person s behavior paired with an inexplicable memory loss synthesizing the fields of psychiatry and the dynamics of the disorder with its influential representation in american fiction the study researches how psychiatry and fiction mutually shaped a mysterious syndrome and how this reciprocal process created a genre fiction of its own that persists until today in a very distinct self referential mode

world war ii known as the great patriotic war to russians ravaged the soviet union and traumatized those who survived after the war memory of this anguish was often publicly repressed under stalin but that all changed by the 1960s under brezhnev the idea of the great patriotic war was transformed into one of victory and celebration in russia s hero cities ivo mijnssen reveals how contradictory national recollections were revised into an idealized past that both served official needs and offered a narrative of

heroism this triumphant narrative was most evident in the creation of 13 hero cities now located across russia belarus and ukraine these cities which were host to some of the fiercest and most famous battles were named champions brezhnev s government officially recognized these cities with awards financial contributions and ritualized festivities their citizens also encountered the altered history at every corner on manicured battlefields in war memorials and through stories at the kitchen table using a rich tapestry of archival material oral history interviews and newspaper articles mijnssen provides a thorough exploration of two cities in particular tula and novorossiysk by exploring the significance of hero cities in soviet identity and the enduring but conflicted importance they hold for russians today russia s hero cities exposes how the great patriotic war no longer has the power to mask the deep rifts still present in russian society

this volume offers a comprehensive examination of hans kelsen s legal and political philosophy focusing on four central themes the first part analyses kelsen s theory of norms including its periodisation and concepts of validity and coercion the second part explores his perspectives on international law addressing its structural analysis primitive law characterisation and teleology the third part examines kelsen s theory of democracy its relationship with the pure theory of law collective will and democratisation of the administration the final part discusses kelsen s influence on the vienna school of legal theory and its impact on case law and jurisprudence beyond europe this collection is essential for scholars and practitioners seeking to understand kelsen s legacy

very few if any have devoted more years to practicing and teaching others to practice the precepts of jesus s sermon on the mount than leo tolstoy he stands apart in the history of interpretation and has had enormous influence on others and other countries yet gandhi or others often get the glory tolstoy is remembered as a great writer but his religious and philosophical works are by and large unknown or disparaged even in scholarly tolstoyan circles his contribution is substantially under appreciated and misunderstood in second tolstoy the sermon on the mount as theo tactics steve hickey captures the particulars and dynamics of tolstoy s interpretation of the sermon on the mount from a deliberately sympathetic vantage point underlying this project is shared belief with tolstoy that the sermon on the mount is liveable and to be lived while from the vantage point of traditional orthodoxy tolstoy got much wrong there remains a lack of appreciation for what he got right radical obedience to the teachings of jesus a new vocabulary is proposed to more precisely capture tolstoyan lived theology namely the political and social expressions of tolstoyan christianity with the hope that these theories and practices will gain a wider consideration understanding and following
