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the lives of a middle aged doctor and a love struck young woman intersect across time in sleeping in eden nicole baart s haunting novel about love jealousy and the boundaries between loyalty and truth she knew what he wrote one little word that made her feel both cheated and beloved one word that changed everything mine on a chilly morning in the northwest iowa town of blackhawk dr lucas hudson is filling in for the vacationing coroner on a seemingly open and shut suicide case his own life is crumbling around him but when he unearths the body of a woman buried in the barn floor beneath the hanging corpse he realizes this terrible discovery could change everything years before lucas ever set foot in blackhawk meg painter met dylan reid it was the summer before high school and the two quickly became inseparable although meg s older neighbor jess was the safe choice she couldn t let go of dylan no matter how hard she tried caught in a web of jealousy and deceit that spiraled out of control meg s choices in the past ultimately collide with lucas s discovery in the present weaving together a taut story of unspoken secrets and the raw complex passions of innocence lost

james kugel s the bible as it was 1997 has been welcomed with universal praise here now is the full scholarly edition of this wonderfully rich and illuminating work expanding the author s findings into an incomparable reference work focusing on two dozen core stories in the pentateuch from the creation and tree of knowledge through the exodus from egypt and journey to the promised land james kugel shows us how the earliest interpreters of the scriptures radically transformed the bible and made it into the book that has come down to us today kugel explains how and why the writers of this formative age of interpretation roughly 200 b c e to 150 c e assumed such a significant role mining their writings including the dead sea scrolls works of philo and josephus and letters of the apostle paul and writings of the apostolic fathers and the rabbinic sages he quotes for us the seminal passages that uncover this crucial interpretive process for this full scale reference work kugel has added a substantial treasury of sources and passages for each of the 24 bible stories it will serve as a unique guide and sourcebook for biblical interpretation

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genesis isaiah and psalms are three key texts in the hebrew bible and represent the lifelong interests of professor john emerton emeritus regius professor of hebrew in the university of cambridge for whom this volume is written on the occasion of his eightieth birthday the contributors have all enjoyed academic relationships with john over the years and represent a truly international group the contributions include comparison of biblical texts with ancient near eastern counterparts and evaluation of them in the light of archaeology they include intertextual work on a literary level and traditional literary historical approaches to texts many move beyond the hebrew bible itself to consider other texts and versions or to draw out interpretations of texts by scholars ancient and modern and even by novelists the result is a refreshing group of articles that indicate the broad range of approaches that characterize the discipline of old testament study in the present day

pete hautman is an author who likes to tackle big ideas from addiction and psychosis to the nature of belief and what the world is coming to in his fiction for teen readers in novels like mr was sweetblood invisible rash and the national book award winner godless hautman leavens his exploration of these big ideas with humor while showing that he understands how overwhelming such matters can be as hautman himself says it s complicated in pete hautman speaking the truth to teens joel shoemaker looks at the life and work of an author whose young adult fiction represent a wider breadth of subject matter and interests than is typically found in any single

author's young adult novels chapters in this book explicate individual novels such as *godless* and *eden west* which focus on religious issues and teens while time travel conundrums are explored in *mr was* and the *klaatu diskos* trilogy and three books look at teens who play poker for very high stakes other works discussed in this study are examples of realistic contemporary fiction *how to steal a car* *blank confession* and two books that take very different approaches to the matter of teens and falling in love *the big crunch* and *what boys really want* shoemaker's interviews with the author and several family members provide opportunities for unique insights into hautman's work drawing clear connections between his life and his writings *pete hautman speaking the truth to teens* will be of interest to librarians scholars and the author's many fans

the exciting follow up to *i will abolish the bow* christianity personhood and the end of animal exploitation *pride goes before destruction* takes a critical look at factory farming which is driven by humanity's pride towards animals fitting to the title this relationship with animals has bled into human affairs as factory farming is responsible not only for animal cruelty but also for antibiotic resistance environmental destruction climate change and many other issues matthew a king criticizes humanity's pride and offers a biblical solution to its consequences the new covenant in jesus christ bristling with persuasive historical evidence and thoughtful biblical interpretation king makes a compelling case for the inclusion of animals within the sphere of christian moral consideration which can help heal humanity's fractured relationship with the planet and even their own health additionally this book answers many questions and offers supplemental material to build on the arguments established in *i will abolish the bow*

leon kellner was part of the intellectual and cultural elite of imperial austria engaged in politics a member of his regional parliament and an essayist of repute he was also a zionist leader and confidant of theodor herzl he created an institution for jews cultural educational and social advancement modelled on london's toynbee hall which spread across east central europe to great effect he was also an internationally recognized shakespeare scholar yet for all this today he is little known how did someone born into a lower middle class orthodox jewish family from the province of galicia come to gain such prominence in the habsburg empire kellner's is a thoroughly habsburg jewish story spanning east and west and shaped by the empire's history politics and culture he was a singular character a galician jew at home in vienna and in czernowitz eyes towards zion yet content also in london and never more so than when absorbed in the minutiae of shakespeare's texts kellner's world was destroyed twice over habsburg austria came to an end in 1918 east central european jewry in 1945 this biography recovers at least part of what was lost

there are many investigations of the old testament priests and the new testament's appropriation of such imagery for jesus christ there are also studies of israel's corporate priesthood and what this means for the priesthood of god's new covenant people in this nsbt volume andrew s malone traces these two distinct threads and their intersection through scripture with an eye to the contemporary christian relevance

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
