the two texts of the dialogue presented here a latin version printed ca 1488 and a middle english translation printed in 1492 preserve lively entertaining and revealing exchanges between the old testament wisdom figure solomon and marcolf a medieval peasant who is ragged and foul mouthed but quick witted and verbally astute the dialogue was a best seller of its day latin versions survive in some twenty seven manuscripts and forty nine early printed editions and the work was translated into a wide variety of late medieval vernaculars including german dutch swedish italian english and welsh

frantisek abel explores one of the topical issues of paul s theology namely the role and influence of the jewish pseudo epigraphs literature written during greek and early roman periods 4th century bce to the 2nd century ce on paul s theological thinking within this corpus the idea of eschatological concepts such as the concept regarding the coming of the messiah and the last judgment in particular arises frequently it is similar in the case of the psalms of solomon with the last judgment as the main topic of this pseudepigraphon through close analysis and exploration of particular parts of this work the author proposes that this deuterocanonical writing could form a considerable background for the proper understanding of paul s messianic ethics from this point of view paul s teaching on justification should be understood as one that is reflective of god s grace while at the same time

expressing faith and deeds as necessary for salvation

in this work ziolkowski pits wise solomon against a wily peasant named marcolf while it is widely known by name until now it has not been translated into any modern language this volume offers an introduction followed by the latin and english detailed commentary and reproductions of woodcut illustrations from the 1514 edition

the uniqueness of this commentary is its detailed first time uncovering of evidence that there were two editions of proverbs the first in the time of solomon and the second in support of king hezekiah s historic religious reforms in this light heretofore puzzling features of the book s design purpose and message are clarified in this light and the book s relevance for its time and ours greatly enhanced

population because it reveals a censored story religious and esoteric scholars find in the testament of solomon a rich source of symbolism and hidden forbidden teachings that offer a different perspective from traditional narratives the book is a fascinating subject of study among theologians occultists historians and believers alike dare to discover the full story of solomon his secrets prophecies and the mysteries revealed by demons

a folkloric research project on sefer ha ma asim in the thirteenth century an anonymous scribe compiled sixty nine tales that became sefer ha ma asim the earliest compilation of hebrew tales known to us in western europe the author writes that the stories encompass descriptions of herbs that cure leprosy a fairy princess with golden tresses using magic charms to heal her lover s wounds and restore him to life a fire breathing dragon a two headed creature and a giant s daughter for whom the rind of a watermelon containing twelve spies is no more than a speck of dust in tales in context sefer ha ma asim in medieval northern france rella kushelevsky enlightens the stories meanings and reflects the circumstances and environment for jewish lives in medieval france although a selection of tales was previously published this is the first publication of a hebrew english annotated edition in its entirety revealing fresh insight the first part of kushelevsky s work cultural literary and comparative perspectives presents the thesis that sefer ha ma asim is a product of its time and place and should therefore be studied within its literary and cultural surroundings jewish and vernacular in northern france an investigation of the scribe s techniques in reworking his jewish and non jewish sources into a medieval discourse supports this claim the second part of the manuscript consists of the tales themselves in hebrew and english translation including brief comparative comments or citations the third part an analytical and comparative overview offers an analysis of each tale as an individual unit contextualized within its medieval framework and against the background of its parallels elisheva baumgarten s epilogue adds social and historical background

to Sefer ha Ma'asim and discusses new ways in which it and other story compilations may be used by historians for an inquiry into the everyday life of medieval Jews. The tales in Sefer ha Ma'asim will be of special value to scholars of folklore and medieval European history and literature as well as those looking to enrich their studies and shelves.
