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this text is divided into sections in order to present an osteopathic approach to dysfunction manifesting in a particular system pertinent to a common clinical presentation the divisions are grouped by their common autonomic and lymphatic elements the purpose of the book is to explore selected structural and functional consideration which may produce symptoms or compromise homeostasis it also demonstrates by example clinical application of the osteopathic philosophy in selected situation lastly it attempts to show where osteopathic manipulative treatments can be

prescribed as primary or adjunctive modalities available to the do as they assist patients in reaching their maximum health potential

systemic autoimmune diseases can affect both the central and peripheral nervous systems in a myriad of ways and through a heterogeneous number of mechanisms leading to many different clinical manifestations as a result neurological complications of these disorders can result in significant morbidity and mortality advances in the diagnosis laboratory investigations and management of these conditions has placed an increasing burden on the practicing clinician to correctly assess and treat these patients this volume of the handbook of the systemic autoimmune diseases will help the clinician and researcher better understand the current concepts of nervous system involvement from systemic autoimmune disorders recognize current approaches to diagnosis and treatment current controversies and areas that need significant research efforts it is believed that providing this approach in a single volume will facilitate its use as a frequent resource for all those caring for or investigating these patients and their diseases each chapter follows a consistent outline to provide the reader with important and useful information in an easy to navigate manner and is also liberally referenced to provide more primary source material for further consideration the standardized approach to each chapter will allow the reader to be able to compare and contrast more efficiently the neurological complications of the autoimmune diseases discussed

this book provides a detailed account of intellectual other neuropsychological and behavioral manifestations of general pediatric diseases the conditions discussed include the whole range of pediatric diseases genetic syndromes other congenital conditions metabolic endocrine gastrointestinal infectious immunologic toxic trauma and neoplastic as well as sensory disabilities including deafness and blindness although the book is not intended to discuss cognitive and behavioral manifestations of conditions usually considered to be primary neurological disease some of those including cerebral palsy muscular dystrophy myotonic dystrophy and epilepsy are included where possible a translational approach is used linking the behavioral and cognitive manifestations of these conditions to the underlying structural chemical or genetic abnormalities and their effect on the brain and in turn on behavior and cognition at the same time included are significant psychosocial factors together those factors have a major effect on patients performance including school performance and on their families this book is unique in its extensive coverage of the major pediatric conditions and of the detailed neurological neuropsychological and behavioral aspects of each condition

this is a manual on diagnosis and treatment of systemic diseases affecting the eye
