own child jocasta entrusts a servant with the task instead who takes the baby to a mountaintop to die of exposure a passing shepherd rescues the baby and names it oedipus or swollen feet taking it with him to corinth where it is raised by the childless king polybus as if it were his own when oedipus hears a rumor that he is not the biological son of polybus he seeks the counsel of the oracle of delphi who relates to him the prophecy of patricide still believing that polybus is his father he flees corinth thus initiating a series of events that would fulfill that which the oracle has prophesied oedipus rex along with its theban counterparts oedipus at colonus and antigone established sophocles as one of the most renowned dramatists of his era this edition follows the translation of e h plumptre includes an introduction by john williams white and is printed on premium acid free paper
