satisfaction within interpersonal relationships plays an extensive role in the overall well being of human beings campbell et al 2005 in light of this there is great significance in studying predictors of relationship satisfaction rs while research on adult attachment aa theory brennan shaver 1995 and conflict resolution cr styles gottman 1994 has found both to independently influence rs there is still little insight into how cr style affects or better explains the relationship between aa style and rs the present study conducted a correlational study to explore these missing links the sample included 477 premarital individuals aged between 18 and 40 years participants completed online questionnaires measuring aa style and cr style and in addition for those currently in a relationship n 271 rs correlation analyses supported previous findings of negative correlations between insecure aa style positive cr styles and rs and positive correlations between secure aa style positive cr styles and rs furthermore mediation analyses found that use of cr styles collaborating compromising and avoidant partially mediated the relationship between aa and rs likewise moderation analyses found the same cr styles to also demonstrate a significant moderation effect between the aa subscales anxiety and avoidance and rs regardless of cr style use rs scores did not differ for those with low aa subscale scores yet with high collaborating compromising use and low avoiding use rs scores were significantly greater for those with high aa subscales scores these results are important as they allow more insight into predictors of rs and aid the development of interventions aimed at helping individuals to adopt more positive styles of resolving interpersonal conflict which may increase not only their satisfaction within their intimate relationships but ultimately in life in general

this study examined the association between individual attachment and interactive conflict styles and the overall influence on marital satisfaction in 207 married individuals the application of attachment theory to this study of adult romantic relationships was established via factor analysis and yielded two dimensions self anxiety and other avoidance accommodation and demand withdraw were the two forms of conflict interaction studied which respectively are constructive and destructive styles of engagement that impact marital satisfaction individuals completed self report measures of attachment accommodation demand withdraw and global marital satisfaction the current study yielded statistically significant results and supported all of the research hypotheses there were negative relationships found between the attachment dimensions of anxiety and avoidance and total accommodation while positive relationships were determined between both attachment dimensions and demand withdraw behaviors in relationship to marital satisfaction an individual's total accommodation was positively related while demand withdraw behaviors were inversely associated there were also inverse relationships found between both the attachment dimensions and marital satisfaction these findings suggest that the data are consistent with previous research on attachment accommodation demand withdraw behavior and marital satisfaction in addition to supporting prior findings this study also had several unique contributions a statistically significant relationship was found between the constructive and destructive conflict styles which suggested total accommodation was associated with lower levels of demand withdraw in addition a path model for the variables of attachment accommodation demand withdraw and marital satisfaction was developed this display of variables is especially useful in showing the bidirectionality of constructive and destructive behaviors in marriage research implications for these findings are presented and suggestions for future research are discussed

married couples n 39 participated in a fifteen minute videotaped interaction during which they discussed an area of disagreement of moderate intensity the wives were classified as autonomous dismissing or preoccupied according to the aai scoring system 1 couples with dismissing wives reported frequencies and intensities of positive and negative emotions similar to those of autonomous wives couples with preoccupied wives reported more frequent and more intense negative emotions and less frequent and less intense positive emotions than couples with autonomous wives an external observer who rated conflict intensity concurred that couples with dismissing wives did not appear to differ in their level of distress from couples with autonomous wives whereas couples with preoccupied wives appeared significantly more distressed 2 despite the observation that couples with dismissing wives seemed to experience emotion with similar frequency and intensity as autonomous wives autonomous wives were more accurate than both dismissing and preoccupied wives when inferring their husbands positive and negative emotions when inferring their husbands thoughts autonomous wives were most accurate they were followed by dismissing wives and preoccupied wives were least accurate conflict intensity was not related to the accuracy of either emotion or thought inferences this study adds to the growing body of evidence that the adult attachment interview aai main goldwyn 1985 1994 has significance for functioning in adult attachment relationships using the empathic accuracy paradigm ickes 1993 2001 this study examines the

relation between wives adult attachment and 1 their reported experience of emotion and 2 the accuracy with which wives are able to infer the feelings and thoughts of their husbands during conflict resolution this study differs from previous studies of empathic accuracy in that it examines feelings and thoughts separately and explores positive and negative emotions separately data from this study provide limited yet encouraging support for crittenden s model of attachment as an emotion cognition balance and for fonagy s theory of reflective functioning

the purpose of this study was to create a comprehensive model integrating adult attachment style conflict style and relationship satisfaction the research sought to determine if adult attachment acted as a predictor of conflict style and if attachment style mediated by conflict style influenced relationship satisfaction three hundred and twenty one undergraduate students in romantic relationships n 321 completed questionnaires measuring attachment style relational conflict style and relationship satisfaction results indicated that highly avoidant individuals are more likely to engage in hostile relational conflict with their partners and feel significantly less satisfaction from their adult romantic relationships than their non avoidant counterparts data also suggested that avoidance and hostility may be more influential on relationship satisfaction levels than anxiety and validation the model in the current study compliments romantic conflict research by offering a predictor for conflict styles in dating relationships and illustrating the influence of both attachment style and conflict style on romantic relationship satisfaction

multiple studies have suggested that communication with family members in the icu is inadequate researchers have found that family members understand less than half of basic patient information family members experience increased anxiety and depression when excluded from decision making and family members often report conflicts with healthcare team hct most strategies to address this gap in communication have been general approaches that have offered a standard package of supports this analysis used an exploratory design with an existing dataset to explore the use of individualized targeted strategies for addressing communication needs of families of icu patients and their hcts the existing dataset of 79 field notes were recorded by trained facilitators as part of a multi center randomized trial of an intervention study designed to improve communication between the hct and families of icu patients data were analyzed using a directed content analysis approach the initial coding scheme was derived from adult attachment theory and moore s theory of conflict and conflict resolution of the 79 field notes the attachment style of the main family member was available for 62 and reflected the proportion reported in other research i e secure 48 versus insecure types including self reliant 34 cautious 10 or support seeking 8 eight communication strategies were identified to improve communication conflicts were identified commonly in the field notes 220 separate conflicts the most common parties involved were families and the hct 162 conflicts family members with cautious attachment experienced the most conflict these findings suggest that trained facilitators can use strategies based on attachment style to improve

communication with family members these facilitators tailored their interactions with self-reliant family members in an effort to encourage a typically reluctant population to ask questions and participate collaboratively in decision making while families with cautious attachment were assisted to build trust and participate collaboratively. Data from this analysis also suggest that family members with cautious attachment may be at risk for conflict with members of the HCT. Finally, HCT members may be more inclined to collaborate when family members have a secure attachment style.
