whereby police officers stop question and frisk ordinary citizens who they may view as
potential suspects on the streets as michael white and hank fradella show in stop and

policing strategy first ruled constitutional in 1968 stop and frisk would go on to become
a central tactic of modern day policing particularly by the new york city police
department by 2011 the nypd recorded 685 000 stop question and frisk interactions with
citizens yet in 2013 a landmark decision ruled that the police had over and mis used this
tactic stop and frisk tells the story of how and why this happened and offers ways that
police departments can better serve their citizens they also offer a convincing argument

that stop and frisk did not contribute as greatly to the drop in new york s crime rates as many proponents like former nypd police commissioner ray kelly and mayor michael bloomberg have argued while much of the book focuses on the nypd s use of stop and frisk examples are also shown from police departments around the country including philadelphia baltimore chicago newark and detroit white and fradella argue that not only does stop and frisk have a legal place in 21st century policing but also that it can be judiciously used to help deter crime in a way that respects the rights and needs of citizens they also offer insight into the history of racial injustice that has all too often been a feature of american policing s history and propose concrete strategies that every police department can follow to improve the way they police a hard hitting yet nuanced analysis stop and frisk shows how the tactic can be a just act of policing and in turn shows how to police in the best interest of citizens
