of the twelve books david foster wallace published both during his lifetime and posthumously only three were novels nevertheless wallace always thought of himself primarily as a novelist from his college years at amherst when he wrote his first novel as part of a creative honors thesis to his final days wallace was buried in a novel project which he often referred to as the long thing meanwhile the short stories and journalistic assignments he worked on during those years he characterized as playing hooky from a certain larger thing wallace was also a specific kind of novelist devoted to producing a specific kind of novel namely the omnivorous culture consuming encyclopedic novel as described in 1976 by edward mendelson in a ground breaking essay on thomas pynchon s gravity s rainbow david foster wallace and the long thing is a state of the art guide through wallace s three major works including the generation defining infinite jest these essays provide fresh new readings of each of wallace s novels as well as thematic essays that trace out patterns and connections across the three works most importantly the collection includes six chapters on wallace s unfinished novel the pale king which will prove to be foundational for future scholars of this important text

fictions of proximity skepticism romanticism and the wallace nexus tells the story of a nexus of contemporary novelists around david foster wallace who took up the legacy of logical positivism and reworked it between the 1980s and the 2000s in a way that has affinities with romanticism the book shows how the writers of this wallace nexus use fiction s complexities to challenge the idea that in human interactions only complete fusion and transparency may count as instances of knowing in place of this positivistic ideal of absorption the book offers the freshly defined concept of proximity a closeness with separateness it reads key novels of contemporary anglo american literature as fictions of proximity i e as texts that dramatize problematize and enact the movement into this position of proximity to tell this story the book draws on unpublished archival materials and understudied connections advancing new interpretations of four novelists david foster wallace david markson bret easton ellis and zadie smith fictions of proximity provides new readings of these writers both of their canonical texts and of lesser known works and situates them with respect to prominent figures in contemporary post positivist philosophy

in literature and the encounter with immanence brynnar swenson collects nine original essays that approach the relationship between literature and immanence through methodologies grounded in the philosophy of spinoza one of spinoza s most provocative claims is a simple declaration of ignorance we do not know what a body can do a literary theory based on immanence privileges the ontological status of the text and the material act of reading rather than ask what a text means the essays here ask what a text can do each essay documents a distinct literary and philosophical encounter with immanence and as a result opens up a space to read literature as one would read philosophy and vice versa

since the start of the financial crisis in 2008 the notion that capitalism has become too abstract for all but the most rarefied specialists to understand has been widely presupposed yet even in academic circles the question of abstraction itself of what exactly abstraction is and does under financialisation seems to have gone largely unexplored or has it by putting the question of abstraction centre stage how abstract is it thinking capital now offers an indispensable counterpoint to the economic turn in the humanities bringing together leading literary and cultural critics in order to propose that we may know far more about capital s myriad abstractions than we typically think we do through in depth engagement with classic and cutting edge theorists agile analyses of recent hollywood films groundbreaking readings of david foster wallace s sprawling unfinished novel the pale king and even original poems the contributors here suggest that the machinations and costs of finance as well as alternatives to it may already be hiding in plain sight this book was originally published as a special issue of textual practice
