He followed Paul as Jesus' surrogate to complete Jesus' mission to bring the gospel to the Gentiles of the Aegean Sea and to the Jews of the Diaspora. Isaiah 49:1-6: "Listen, O islands, to me and hearken, you Jewish people, from far, the Lord has called me from the womb. He said, 'It is a light thing that you would be my servant to restore the preserved of Israel. I will also give you for a light to the Gentiles so that you may be my salvation to the end of the earth.' The first part of the book of Acts asks, 'Can even Gentiles be saved?' but the last part focuses on Luke's real message: the congregation should continue to look equally Jewish and Gentile, even though Gentiles become far more numerous in the congregation. This is God's highest purpose: gathering two into the one body of Messiah. According to Ephesians, all Paul's epistles were written by the end of Acts 28. There's no need for a speculated release and second Roman imprisonment.
