speaker tsou shows how these texts use figurative means to confront the problem of race she also explores how traces of asian american history live on through these figures each case study in unquiet tropes considers a different scenario defiance coercion necessity error and deceit to show how literary representation from the 1950s through 1997 has responded to a specific political condition

leading scholars provide illuminating and engaging perspectives on a long neglected yet incredibly eventful period 1930 1965 of asian american literature

as the essays collectively argue asian american rhetoric not only reflects and responds to existing social and cultural conditions and practices but also interacts with and influences such conditions and practices in the process it becomes a rhetoric of becoming that always negotiates with adjusts to and yields an imagined identity and agency that is asian american
