READY FOR THE NEXT LEVEL OF LEARN TO READ WITH IMAGES ONCE READERS CAN CORRECTLY IDENTIFY A WORD AND ITS CONNECTION TO THE LEARNING IMAGE THEY ARE READY FOR THE NEXT LEVEL OF LEARN TO READ WITH IMAGES THERE ARE SEVERAL SIGHT WORDS IN THE TEXT FOR YOUNGER CHILDREN IT IS RECOMMENDED TO COUNT THE NUMBER OF WORDS IN THE TEXT UPPER HALF OF THE PAGE AND DO THE SAME FOR THE LEARNING IMAGES BOTTOM HALF OF THE PAGE THIS IS A USEFUL PROMPT TO REMIND CHILDREN THAT NOT ALL WORDS IN THE TEXT ARE CONNECTED TO A LEARNING IMAGE AND THEREFORE THEY MUST READ FROM MEMORY AS CHILDREN MOVE UP THE LEVELS THEY WILL RECOGNIZE AND STRENGTHEN THEIR RECOGNITION OF WORDS MAKING THEM MORE
