estimates of di s effectiveness are consistent over time with different research approaches across different school environments students from all types of backgrounds different comparative programs and both academic achievement and non academic outcomes including student self confidence effects are substantially stronger than those reported for other curricula when students have di for more time and when teachers implement the programs as designed the effects are even stronger results indicate that di has the potential to dramatically change patterns of student achievement in the united states in an even handed style accessible to policy makers educators and parents the authors describe the theory underlying di its development use and history systematically examine criticisms and discuss policy implications extensive appendices provide detailed information for researchers
