euthanasia has been a matter of great controversy in the present and the past scholars have attempted to rationalise the conflicts for and against a person's right to choose to die from age moral legal cultural and economic perspectives psychologically an individual's preestablished notions of attitudes toward death could also influence their euthanasia beliefs past research has inadequately represented the influence as solely one's death anxiety this thesis aims to examine the associations between death attitudes and euthanasia beliefs using a comprehensive death attitude profile as well as selected personal factors such as religion and age the study was conducted via an open invitation online questionnaire to two different sample groups namely the general public gp and participants from the volunteer euthanasia society new zealand yes from the 378 sample responses received 141 participants were from yes with the remaining 237 from the general population unsurprisingly survey participants from yes exhibited greater euthanasia beliefs due to their background the findings revealed that yes subjects displayed lower levels of fear of death death avoidance and approach acceptance and greater levels of neutral acceptance and escape acceptance in the death attitude profile scores when compared with the gp group a statistically significant difference in euthanasia belief strength was only found for those participants with a religion in the gp group furthermore religious belief had a significant effect on the approach acceptance neutral acceptance and fear of death elements of death attitudes results reported strong associations between euthanasia beliefs and religious belief neutral and approach acceptances attitudes for the gp group this is attributed to the effect of religious teachings the yes group demonstrated strong associations between euthanasia beliefs and age and death avoidance which is likely due to strong in favour of euthanasia the study recommends further exploration with a more defined measure for euthanasia belief elements
