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eleanor cameron 1912 1996 was an innovative and genre defying author of children s fiction and children s literature criticism from her beginnings as a librarian cameron went on to become a prominent and respected voice in children s literature writing one of the most beloved children s science fiction novels of all time the wonderful flight to the mushroom planet and later winning the national book award for her time fantasy the court of the stone children in addition eleanor cameron played an often vocal role in critical debates about children s literature she was one of the first authors to take up literary criticism of children s novels and published two influential books of criticism including the green and burning tree one of cameron s most notable acts of criticism came in 1973 when she wrote a scathing critique of roald dahl s charlie and the chocolate factory dahl responded in kind and the result was a fiery imbroglio within the pages of the horn book magazine yet despite her many accomplishments most of cameron s books went out of print by the end of her life and her star faded this biography aims to reinsert cameron into the conversation by taking an in depth look at her tumultuous early life in ohio and california her unforgettably forceful personality and criticism and her graceful heartfelt novels the biography includes detailed analysis of the creative process behind each of her published works and how cameron s feminism environmentalism and strong sense of ethics are reflected in and represented by her writings drawn from over twenty interviews thousands of letters and several unpublished manuscripts in her personal papers eleanor cameron is a tour of the most exciting and creative periods of american children s literature through the experience of one of its valiant purveyors and champions

samuel h yamashita s hawai i regional cuisine the food movement that changed the way hawai i eats is the first in depth study on the origins philosophy development and legacy of hawai i regional cuisine hrc the book is based on interviews with thirty six chefs farmers retailers culinary arts educators and food writers as well as on nearly everything written about the hrc chefs in the national and local media yamashita follows the history of this important regional movement from its origins in 1991 through the following decades offering a boldly original analysis of its cuisine and impact on the islands the founding group of twelve chefs sam choy roger dikon mark ellman amy ferguson ota beverly gannon jean marie josselin george mavrothalassitis peter merriman philippe padovani gary strehl alan wong and roy yamaguchi grandly announced in august 1991 the establishment of what they called hawai i regional cuisine at the time they had no idea how dramatically they would change the food scene in the islands while they each had their own style their common commitment to using fresh locally sourced ingredients of the highest quality at their restaurants quickly attracted the interest of journalists writing for national newspapers and magazines the final chapters close with a discussion of the leading chefs of the next generation and an assessment of hrc s impact on farming fishing ranching aquaculture and culinary education in the islands hawai i regional cuisine will satisfy those who are passionate about food and intrigued by changes in local foodways

a data rich study of the difficult partnerships between the colleges universities and businesses of silicon valley universities and colleges often operate between two worlds higher education and economic systems with a mission rooted in research teaching and public service institutions of higher learning are also economic drivers in their regions under increasing pressure to provide skilled workers to local companies it is impossible to understand how current developments are affecting colleges without attending to the changes in both the higher education system and in the economic communities in which they exist w richard scott michael w kirst and colleagues focus on the changing relations between colleges and companies in one vibrant economic region the san francisco bay area colleges and tech companies they argue have a common interest in knowledge generation and human capital but they operate in social worlds that substantially differ making them uneasy partners colleges are a part of a long tradition that stresses the importance of precedent academic values and liberal education high tech companies by contrast value innovation and know how and they operate under conditions that reward rapid response to changing opportunities the economy is changing faster than the postsecondary education system drawing on quantitative and historical data from 1970 to 2012 as well as 14 case studies of colleges this book describes a rich and often tense relationship between higher education and the tech industry it focuses on the ways in which various types of colleges have endeavored and often failed to meet the demands of a vibrant economy and concludes with a discussion of current policy recommendations suggestions for improvements and reforms at the state level and a proposal to develop a regional body to better align educational and economic development

like a modern day jane jacob's janette sadik khan transformed new york city's streets to make room for pedestrians cyclists buses and green spaces describing the battles she fought to enact change streetfight imparts wisdom and practical advice that other cities can follow to make their own streets safer and more vibrant as new york city's transportation commissioner janette sadik khan managed the seemingly impossible and transformed the streets of one of the world's greatest toughest cities into dynamic spaces safe for pedestrians and cyclists her approach was dramatic and effective simply painting a part of the street to make it into a plaza or bus lane not only made the street safer but it also lessened congestion and increased foot traffic which improved the bottom line of businesses real life experience confirmed that if you know how to read the street you can make it function better by not totally reconstructing it but by reallocating the space that's already there breaking the street into its component parts streetfight demonstrates with step by step visuals how to rewrite the underlying source code of a street with pointers on how to add

protected bike paths improve crosswalk space and provide visual cues to reduce speeding achieving such a radical overhaul wasn't easy and streetfight pulls back the curtain on the battles sadik khan won to make her approach work she includes examples of how this new way to read the streets has already made its way around the world from pocket parks in mexico city and los angeles to more pedestrian friendly streets in auckland and buenos aires and innovative bike lane designs and plazas in austin indianapolis and san francisco many are inspired by the changes taking place in new york city and are based on the same techniques streetfight deconstructs reassembles and reinvents the street inviting readers to see it in ways they never imagined

metamorphic imagery in ancient chinese art and religion demonstrates that the concept of metamorphism was central to ancient chinese religious belief and practices from at least the late neolithic period through the warring states period of the zhou dynasty central to the authors argument is the ubiquitous motif in early chinese figurative art the metamorphic power mask while the motif underwent stylistic variation over time its formal properties remained stable underscoring the image s ongoing religious centrality it symbolized the metamorphosis through the phenomenon of death of royal personages from living humans to deceased ancestors who required worship and sacrificial offerings treated with deference and respect the royal ancestors lent support to their living descendants ratifying and upholding their rule neglected they became dangerous even malevolent employing a multidisciplinary approach that integrates archaeologically recovered objects with literary evidence from oracle bone and bronze inscriptions to canonical texts all situated in the appropriate historical context the study presents detailed analyses of form and style and of change over time observing the importance of relationality and the dynamic between imagery materials and affects this book is a significant publication in the field of early china studies presenting an integrated conception of ancient art and religion that

in reconfiguring racial capitalism mingwei huang traces the development of new forms of racial capitalism in the twenty first century through fieldwork in one of the china malls that has emerged along johannesburg s former mining belt huang identifies everyday relations of power and difference between chinese entrepreneurs and african migrant workers in these wholesale shops these relations huang contends replicate and perpetuate global structures of white supremacy anti blackness capitalism and colonialism even when whiteness is not present huang argues that this dynamic reflects the sedimented legacies and continued operation of white supremacy and colonialism which have been transformed in the shift of capitalism s center of gravity toward china and the global south these new forms of racial capitalism and empire layer onto and extend histories of exploitation and racialization in south africa taking a palimpsestic approach huang offers tools for understanding this shift and decentering contemporary western conceptions of race empire and racial capitalism in the chinese century
