in october 1967 one year after the founding of the black panther party huey newton was involved in a shooting during which an oakland police officer was killed newton spent three years in prison before being released and having his charges dismissed and his jailing brought

curtis j austin s up against the wall chronicles how violence brought about the founding of the black panther party in 1966 by huey p newton and bobby seale dominated its policies and finally destroyed the party as one member after another eldridge cleaver fred hampton alex rackley left the party was killed or was imprisoned austin shows how the party s early emphasis in the 1960s on self defense though sorely needed in black communities at the time left it open to mischaracterization infiltration and devastation by local state and federal police forces and government agencies austin carefully highlights the internal tension between advocates of a more radical position than the panthers took who insisted on military confrontation with the state and those such as newton and david hilliard who believed in community organizing and alliance building as first priorities austin interviewed a number of party members who had heretofore remained silent with the help of these stories austin is able to put the violent history of the party in perspective and show that the survival programs such as the free breakfast for children program and free health clinics helped the black communities they served to recognize their own bases of power and ability to save themselves

from a brilliant young legal scholar comes this sweeping history of american ideas of belonging and citizenship told through the stories of fourteen legal cases that helped to shape our nation spanning three centuries black trials details the legal challenges and struggles that helped

define the ever shifting identity of blacks in america from the well known cases of plessy v ferguson and the clarence thomas confirmation hearings to the more obscure trial of joseph hanco an eighteenth century free black man accused of murdering his wife and bringing smallpox to boston weiner recounts the essential dramas of american identity illuminating where our conception of minority rights has come from and where it might go significant and enthralling these are the cases that forced the courts and the country to reconsider what it means to be black in america and mark weiner demonstrates their lasting importance for our society

huey p newton s family roots of a revolutionary suicide was undertaken by the author at the request of prof emeritus melvin newton older brother of huey newton melvin s daughter tracy newton and son david lautaro newton the project involved extensive family interviews and research to cover the background of melvin and huey p newton s parents walter and armelia newton the tribal nature of family interactions the lives of their siblings and other close relatives their seven children and the collective family impact on walter and armelia s youngest son iconic black militant huey p newton who co founded the black panther party newton wrote in his autobiography revolutionary suicide and testified to a captivated audience in his 1968 death penalty trial that an understanding of the treatment of african americans since colonial days was necessary to understand who he was and where he came from that testimony had a profound impact on the jury that had newton s life in their hands particularly affecting middleclass black banker david harper who became the jury s revolutionary choice for foreman this book puts huey p newton s experiences and those of his family into historical context it starts with walter newton s heritage and his wife armelia johnson newton s family background from their primarily african roots to their caucasian ancestors to the slavery of their african american ancestors to their upbringing in the segregated south their hard scrabble adult lives in arkansas and louisiana in the early 20th century their move west to oakland as part of the great migration the racism they faced in california huey and melvin newton s disparate school experiences huey s teenage years his involvement in the afro american association s informal studies of black authors melvin s role in creating a pioneering ethnic studies program at oakland s merritt college the formation of the black panther party the shootout with two oakland police officers for which the panther leader was arrested and that became the focus of international attention to the treatment of black men by the american justice system huey newton s historic 1968 death penalty trial his mafia phase his subsequent cuban exile his frayed and reestablished family

the black panther party represents black panther party members coordinated responses over the last four decades to the failure of city state and federal bureaucrats to address the basic needs of their respective communities the party pioneered free social service programs that are now in the mainstream of american life the party s sickle cell anemia research foundation operated with oakland s children s hospital was among the nation s first such testing programs its free breakfast program served as a model for national programs other initiatives included free clinics grocery giveaways school and education programs senior programs and legal aid programs published here for the first time in book form the black panther party makes the case

that the programs methods are viable models for addressing the persistent basic social injustices and economic problems of today's American cities and suburbs

Although whites are bombarded with heroic images of themselves in textbooks, television, and the big screen, violently defeating their enemies both real and imagined, and Black self-destruction is made infamous via various media, there is a remarkable void of comprehensive literature addressing how oppressed Blacks have historically committed the ultimate act of self-defense: killing their definitive enemy. The ability of institutionalized White supremacy to deny the historical existence of armed Black rebellion against White supremacy is what makes it truly powerful. According to Newton's definition of power, which is not in terms of how many people you can control to us, power is first of all the ability to define phenomena, and secondly the ability to make these phenomena act in a desired manner. According to Gayraud Wilmore, it now seems clear that notwithstanding the suppression of information, the whole issue of Black insurrections was underplayed partly because of that peculiar racist predisposition of many to remember the Negroes as docile, accommodating collaborators in their own misery, waiting for whites to give them their freedom. Malcolm X proposed that when you select heroes about which Black people ought to be taught, let them be Black heroes who have died fighting for the benefit of Black people. We need to be taught about Black people who
