no blacks no irish no dogs the untold history of racism in britain there are moments in history when cruelty is displayed not with violence but with ink and paper no blacks no irish no dogs wasn't just a sign in a window it was a message a public declaration that some people were simply not welcome that message wasn't hidden it was advertised it wasn't isolated it was widespread this book is about that message where it came from how it was justified and what it did to the people it targeted after world war ii britain needed help rebuilding so it turned to the very people it once ruled over caribbean irish african and south asian men and women who believed in the promise of the mother country they arrived in search of opportunity belonging and dignity instead they were met with closed doors suspicion and systemic exclusion we often hear britain described as a tolerant nation but behind that image is a history of subtle and not so subtle racism of discriminatory housing laws hostile media segregated schools and over policed neighbourhoods unlike the overt brutality of racism in other countries british racism was quiet bureaucratic and deeply embedded this book tells the untold stories of the people who lived through that era it sheds light on the everyday discrimination that shaped lives while also highlighting the strength resistance and resilience of communities who refused to disappear to understand britain today we must reckon with the ghosts of the signs we no longer see but whose legacy still lingers this book is for the voices once silenced it is for the stories never taught in school it is for the generations who deserve to know the full truth brian phokeerdoss 2025
