needed to cultivate a high level of military effectiveness despite its struggle to develop and maintain professionalism the officer corps was often hampered by factors inextricably intertwined with the soviet state marxist theory revolutionary ideology friction between party and non party members and the influence of the army s political administration organs reese shows that by rejecting the western bourgeois model of military professionalism the state greatly limited its officer corps ability to develop a more effective military while a sense of group identity emerged among officers after world war ii it quickly lost relevance in the face of postwar challenges especially the war in afghanistan which underscored fatal flaws in command leadership red commanders offers new insight into the workings of a military giant and also restores leon trotsky to his rightful place in soviet military history by featuring his ideas on building a new army from the ground up it is an important look behind the scenes at a military establishment that continues to face leadership challenges in russia today
