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in early 1928 during a time of pioneering long distance flights two new zealand pilots set off from australia on the first attempted aerial crossing of the wild tasman sea amid fervent hope government interference a spirit of patriotism

wide newspaper coverage and family pride john scotty moncrieff and george hood along with their non flying partner ivan kight dreamed of closer british empire ties a safer new zealand and a shot at aviation glory the disappearance of their aircraft aotearoa remains one of australasias great flying mysteries bill conroy has researched this fascinating and tragic story for more than three decades in the first full length examination of moncrieff and hoods flight he recounts the conception planning execution and aftermath of the project which enthralled both sides of the tasman

i had no money could get no floats my navigation was uncertain plane inadequate a true story filled with danger adventure and achievement alone over the tasman sea is sir francis chichester s telling of his 1931 seaplane solo flight over the tasman sea from new zealand to australia the first of its kind told with dry wit and humour chichester recounts his perilous journey across uncharted sea and between remote islands and how he overcame the many obstacles along the way during an era when flight was still in its dangerous infancy chichester s pure reliance on his friends instinct and reason make this a fascinating tale of risk taking perseverance and courage

as a group of islands in the far south west pacific ocean new zealand has a history that is steeped in the sea its people have encountered the sea in many different ways along the coast in port on ships beneath the waves behind a camera and in the realm of the imagination while new zealanders have continually altered their marine environments the ocean too has influenced their lives a multi disciplinary work encompassing history marine science archaeology and visual culture new zealand and the sea explores new zealand s varied relationship with the sea challenging the conventional view that history unfolds on land leading and emerging scholars highlight the dynamic ocean centred

history of these islands and their inhabitants offering fascinating new perspectives on new zealand s pasts the ocean has profoundly shaped culture across this narrow archipelago the meeting of land and sea is central in historical accounts of polynesian discovery and colonisation european exploratory voyaging sealing whaling and the littoral communities that supported these plural occupations and the mass migrant passage from britain frances steel

the second edition of this popular book has been completely rewritten and expanded it covers every one of the 757 open coast beaches as well as 120 beaches in five large bays including sydney harbour

the book begins with the turmoil plaguing her family and relations in the ukraine before and post wwi progressing into the chaos of four years of the russian civil war maria is born in a small village with the country under communist control as a young girl she suffered hunger and starvation in the holodomor in 1933 in the ukraine a made famine authorised by stalin this was followed by the terror purges carried out by the nkvd after a short period of peace came the german invasion and occupation she was selected by the germans for slave labour where she was sent to germany to work in an ammunition factory she escaped to magdeburg and lived in german society under an assumed name here she experience the horror of allied bombing and consequent firestorm with the end of wwii she was liberated by the americans who handed her over to the soviets from the eastern block she escaped back to the west to meet up with her future husband in the small german town of goslar she married and in time she had a son for four years the family lived in germany as displaced people with the constant fear of being repatriated to the ussr eventually new zealand opened its door and a month long voyage by sea eventually landed the family in a strange land halfway around the world life in new zealand presented its own problems to foreigners who had little to no understanding of the english language but by hard work and much sacrifice she achieved her goal of owning a house and a growing family

distinctively this book brings together an end to end understanding of heatwaves that is a consideration of their causes consequences for human and natural systems and societal responses to them in the form of adaptation and mitigation actions it advocates for recognizing the heatwave imperative and emphasizes that heatwaves matter together the individual chapters make the point that knowing heatwaves from a holistic interdisciplinary perspective will assist with efforts towards heatwave risk reduction and building resilience to what is
