sklansky traces a shift in american social thought as the gradual demise of the household economy rendered proprietary independence an increasingly embattled ideal amid the widening class divide nineteenth century social theorists devised a new science of american society that reconceived freedom in terms of psychic self expression instead of economic self interest and they redefined democracy in terms of cultural kinship rather than social compact

do we all possess a soul if so what is it can it be defined crawford argues that it is important that we have a soul because if it is immortal then we can hope for life after death but some religions insist that it is the resurrection of the body which is vital how can the belief in an immortal soul and resurrection of the body be reconciled crawford attempts to answer this question in the context of six world religions and the science and technology of twenty first century society

the soul works through the mechanism of a threefold personality the method by which the soul and the personality vehicles interact and function together is presented in this volume and also the way the human constitution as a whole and in its component parts responds to the impact of an evolving consciousness

in a culture in which science is believed to hold the answers to every question spiritual realities like the soul are often ignored or ridiculed we are told that neuroscience holds the key to explaining every aspect of human behavior yet christian philosopher j p moreland argues that scripture sound philosophical reasoning and everyday experience all point to the reality of an immaterial soul countering the arguments of both naturalists and christian scholars who embrace a material only view of humanity moreland demonstrates why it is both biblical and reasonable to believe humans are essentially spiritual beings he also describes the various components of the soul and how christians can nurture their souls as disciples of christ moreland shows that neuroscience and the soul are not competing explanations of human activity but that both coexist and influence one another

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
