this book studies the working efficacy of leonard cohen s song hallelujah in the context of today s network culture especially as recorded on youtube k d lang s interpretation s of cohen s hallelujah embody acoustically and visually viscerally what nietzsche named the spirit of music today the working of music is magnified and transformed by recording dynamics and mediated via facebook exchanges blog postings and video sites given the sexual religious core of cohen s hallelujah this study poses a phenomenological reading of the objectification of both men and women raising the question of desire including gender issues and both homosexual and heterosexual desire a review of critical thinking about musical performance as currency and consumed commodity takes up adorno s reading of benjamin s analysis of the work of art in the age of mechanical reproduction as applied to music radio sound and the persistent role of recording consciousness ultimately the question of what nietzsche called the becoming human of dissonance is explored in terms of both ancient tragedy and beethoven s striking deployment of dissonance as nietzsche analyses both as playing with suffering discontent and pain itself a playing for the sake not of language or sense but musically as joy

a man of many hats leonard cohen currently in his mid seventies is so much more than the consummate songwriter and performer most eagerly associated with his name on top of the hugely influential music and poetry and the shows that even now receive enormous critical acclaim cohen is a novelist of considerable repute a master of dry but hilarious comedy always ready with an amusing anecdote and an explorer of his inner being having spent five years in the 1990s at a buddhist monastery meditating for up to 12 hours a day authoritative but often wryly amusing this book tells the whole cohen story from his birth in 1934 through to his triumphant 2009 concert tour featuring numerous new and exclusive interviews with some of cohen s key associates and including brand new research which reveals many previously unreported details leonard cohen hallelujah a new biography will remain the standard work on the man for many years to come jacket

both dylan and cohen have been a presence on the music and poetry landscape spanning six decades this book begins with a discussion of their contemporary importance and how they have sustained their enduring appeal as performers and recording artists the authors argue that both dylan and

cohen shared early aspirations that mirrored the beat generation they sought to achieve the fame of dylan thomas who proved a bohemian poet could thrive outside the academy and to live his life of unconditional social irresponsibility while dylan s and cohen s fame fluctuated over the decades it was sustained by self consciously adopted personas used to distance themselves from their public selves this separation of self requires an exploration of the artists relation to religion as an avenue to find and preserve inner identity the relationship between their lyrics and poetry is explored in the context of federico garcía lorca s concept of the poetry of inspiration and the emotional depths of duende such ideas draw upon the dislocation of the mind and the liberation of the senses that so struck dylan and cohen when they first read the poetry and letters of arthur rimbaud and lorca the authors show that performance and the poetry are integral and the duende or passion of the delivery is inseparable from the lyric or poetry and common to dylan cohen and the beat generation

in this philosophical biography liel leibovitz looks at what it is that makes leonard cohen an enduring cultural icon born into a religious jewish family for years a reclusive lyricist on the greek island of hydra known for his bold political commentary his devotion to buddhist thought and his later despair over contemporary zionism cohen hardly follows the rules of rock convention yet the prophetic themes of his music often filled with pessimism and apocalyptic visions prove redemptive to an audience that spans generations from those who listened in the 1960 s to today

a look not only at the inner man but also at the environments that shaped leonard cohen from the rock scene of new york in the 1960s to the remote zen monastery where cohen spent years later in life

covering the musical practice of one artist recording or performing another composer's song has always been an attribute of popular music in 2009 the internet database second hand songs estimated that there are 40 000 songs with at least one cover version some of the more common variations of this appropriationist method of musical quotation include traditional forms such as patriotic anthems religious hymns such as amazing grace muzak's instrumental interpretations christmas classics and children's songs novelty and comedy collections from parodists such as weird al yankovic also align in the cover category as does the larcenous art of sampling and technological variations in dance remixes and mash ups film and television soundtracks and advertisers increasingly rely on versions of familiar pop tunes to assist in marketing their narratives and products the cover phenomenon in popular culture may be viewed as a postmodern manifestation in music as artists revisit reinterpret and re-examine a significant cross section of musical styles periods genres individual records and other artists and their catalogues of works the cover complex with its multiple variations issues contexts and re-contextualizations comprises an important and rich popular culture text these re-recordings represent artifacts which embody artistic social cultural historical commercial biographical and novel meanings through homage allusion apprenticeship and parody among other modes these diverse musical quotations express preserve and distribute popular culture popular music and their intersecting historical narratives play it again represents the first collection of critical perspectives on the many facets of cover songs in popular music

in 2016 the music world lost more than its share of iconic figures david bowie glen frey prince and then in the final months of the year we lost the master leonard cohen passed away on the 7th november 2016 and this book covers the feelings that he instilled in his fans all over the world from canada to costa rica from belgium to bhutan from the uk to the usa and many more countries in between this is a book written from the fans perspective written by fans and compiled and authored by a fan ian carroll featuring stories and memories and even a selection of poems written on his passing this is a true memorial to the man himself great memories of a music legend with a back catalogue steeped in beautiful music and lyrics

leonard cohen has aimed high to be all jewish heroes at once like jacob he struggled with angels like david he sang psalms and seduced women but he never ceased doing what he did best going from city to city and reviving our hearts leonard cohen the man who saw the angels fall follows the singer's

cosmopolitan life from montreal and new york to the greek island of hydra and examines his perpetual dialogues with himself god and avalanches we see how six decades of radiant pessimism and a few thousand nights in hotel rooms transformed a young jewish poet who longed to be a saint into an existentialist troubadour in love with women and a gravelly voiced crooner who taught a thousand ways of dissolving into love after more than two decades of research and travels christophe lebold who befriended the poet and spent time with him in los angeles delivers a stimulating analysis of cohen s life and art gracefully blending biography and essay he interrogates the mission cohen set out for himself to show us that darkness is just the flip side of light

the contemporary leonard cohen is an exciting new study that offers an original explanation of leonard cohen s staying power and his various positions in music literature and art the death of leonard cohen received media attention across the globe and this international star remains dear to the hearts of many fans this book examines the diversity of cohen s art in the wake of his death positioning him as a contemporary multi media artist whose career was framed by the twentieth century and neoliberal contexts of its production the authors borrow the idea of the contemporary especially from philosophy and art history applying it to cohen for the first time not only to the drawings that he included in some of his books but also to his songs poems and novels this idea helps us to understand cohen s techniques after his postmodern experiments with poems and novels in the 1960s and 1970s it also helps us to see how his most recent songs poems and drawings developed out of that earlier material including earlier connections to other writers and musicians philosophically the contemporary also sounds out the deep feelings that cohen s work still generates in readers and listeners whether these feelings are spiritual or secular sincere or ironic we get them partly from the sense of timeliness and the sense of timelessness in cohen s lyrics and images which speak to our own lives and times our own struggles and survival from a set of international collaborators the contemporary leonard cohen delivers an appreciative but critical examination of one of our dark luminaries

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when i m your fan the songs of leonard cohen hit stores in 1991 leonard cohen s career had plummeted from its revered 1960s high cohen s record label had refused to release his 1984 album various positions including the song hallelujah in the united states luckily velvet underground founder john cale was one of the few who did hear hallelujah and he covered it for i m your fan a collection of cohen s songs produced by a french fanzine jeff buckley adored the tribute album and covered cale s cover in 1994 never having heard cohen s still obscure original version in 2016 stereogum labeled the tribute album possibly the most universally derided format in pop music however without a tribute album you wouldn t know the song hallelujah through buckley through cale hallelujah is now one of the most often performed songs in the world and it wouldn t be without this tribute album i m your fan thus offers a particularly notable example of a much broader truth despite all the eye rolling they inspire tribute albums matter they can resuscitate legends fading careers or expose obscure artists who never had much of a career to begin with

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
