of description not of explanations these are two quite different intellectual territories smith writes about what can be observed not philosophized about thus he does not discuss the inner workings of the human brain his claim is that what he is interested in thinking learning understanding remembering have never been found in the brain the aim is to describe the scope and limits for how we can be seen to think learn understand and remember but not to explain such behavior by recourse to hypothetical inner entities ourselves speaks especially to educators it outlines the possibilities and limitations inherent in all of us it delineates who we are but also stresses that no two people are the same that what we become depends on our journeys in life and the people we encounter on the way the formal part of learning that is called education is particularly sensitive to the role of people who organize critical experiences for us our teachers the brief summaries at the end of each chapter reinforce and highlight points that are of particular relevance to teachers researchers professionals and graduate students across the fields of literacy education psychology of reading learning theory human learning educational psychology and psycholinguistics will find this book compelling
