kevin slack sounds the alarm on how america s failed neoliberal regime has given way to a woke oligarchy that has deployed a radical toolkit to rapidly strip away the rights of citizens americans often use the words progressive liberal and radical more or less interchangeably without reference to their place in our nation s history kevin slack clarifies the distinct aims of the movements they represent and weighs their consequences for the american republic each of the three movements rejected older republican principles of governance in favor of an administrative state but there were substantial differences between teddy roosevelt s anglo protestant progressive social gospelers who battled trusts and curbed immigration franklin roosevelt and lyndon johnson s secular liberals who initiated government business partnership and a civil rights agenda and the 1960s radicals who protested corporate influence in the great

society liberal hypocrisy on race and gender and the war in vietnam each movement arose in criticism of what came before following the revolution of the 1960s elites on both left and right turned against the industrial middle class to erect an oligarchy at home and advance globalization abroad each side claimed to serve the interests of disadvantaged or underrepresented groups radicals ensconced themselves in bureaucracy and academia to fulfill their vision of social justice for women and minorities while neoliberal elites promoted monopoly finance open borders and outsourcing of jobs to benefit consumers the administrative state had become a global american empire but the neoliberals economic and military failures precipitated a crisis of legitimacy in the great awakening that began under barack obama neoliberal elites including establishment conservatives openly broke with the populist base of the republican party embraced identity politics and used covid 19 and myths of insurrection to strip away the rights of american citizens today an incompetent kleptocracy is draining the wealthiest and most powerful people in history thus eroding the foundations of its own empire this book traces the rise and fall of the american republic

the constitution has governed the united states since 1789 but many americans are not aware of the structural rules that govern the oldest democracy in the world important public policy challenges require a knowledgeable interested citizenry able to address the issues that represent the rich pageantry of american society issues such as climate change national debt poverty pandemics income inequality and more can be addressed sufficiently if citizens play an active role in their own republic collectively citizens are vulnerable to exploitation and manipulation if we place limits on our individual political knowledge a more informed engaged citizenry can best rise to the great policy challenges of contemporary society and beyond brian l fife provides readers with essential information on all aspects of american politics showing them how to use political knowledge to shape the future of the republic activist citizens are the key to making the united states a more vibrant democracy fife equips citizens and would be citizens with the tools and understanding they need to engage fully in the political process at the end of each chapter he analyzes why citizenship matters and how citizens can use that chapter s material in their own lives fife also provides readers with a citizen homework section that presents web links to further explore issues raised in each chapter

the role of religion in the founding of america has long been a hotly debated question some historians have regarded the views of a few famous founders such as benjamin franklin thomas jefferson james madison and thomas paine as evidence that the founders were deists who advocated the strict separation of church and state popular christian polemicists on the other hand have attempted to show that virtually all of the founders were pious christians in favor of public support for religion as the essays in this volume demonstrate a diverse array of religious traditions informed the political culture of the american founding faith and the founders of the american republic includes studies both of minority faiths such as islam and judaism and of major traditions like calvinism it also includes nuanced analysis of specific founders quaker fellow traveler john dickinson prominent baptists isaac backus and john leland and theistic rationalist gouverneur morris among others with attention to their personal histories faiths constitutional philosophies and views on the relationship between religion and the state this volume will be a crucial resource for anyone interested in the place of faith in the founding of the american constitutional republic from political religious historical and legal perspectives

constitutional thought is currently dominated by heroic tales of the founding fathers who built an enlightenment machine that can tick tock its way into the twenty first century with a little fine tuning by the supreme court however according to bruce ackerman the modern presidency is far more dangerous today than it was when arthur Schlesinger published the imperial presidency in 1973 in this book he explores how the interaction of changes in the party system mass communications the bureaucracy and the military have made the modern presidency too powerful and a threat to liberal constitutionalism and democracy ackerman argues that the principles of constitutional legitimacy have been undermined by both political and legal factors on the political level by government by emergency and government by public opinion poll on the legal by two rising institutions the office of legal counsel in the department of justice and the office of the presidential counsel in the white house both institutions came out

of the new deal but have gained prominence only in the last generation lastly ackerman kicks off a reform debate that aims to adapt the founding ideal of checks and balances to twenty first century realities his aim is not to propose definitive solutions but to provoke a national debate on american democracy in its time of trouble

one of leading figures of his day roger sherman was a member of the five man committee that drafted the declaration of independence and an influential delegate at the constitutional convention as a representative and senator in the new republic he had a hand in determining the proper scope of the national government s power as well as drafting the bill of rights in roger sherman and the creation of the american republic mark david hall explores sherman s political theory and shows how it informed his many contributions to america s founding a close examination of sherman s religious beliefs provides insight into how those beliefs informed his political actions hall shows that sherman like many founders was influenced by calvinist political thought a tradition that played a role in the founding generation s opposition to great britain and led them to develop political institutions designed to prevent corruption promote virtue and protect rights contrary to oft repeated assertions that the founders advocated a strictly secular policy hall argues persuasively that most founders believed christianity should play an important role in the new american republic

timothy pickering was an important figure in the early american republic for more than fifty years he was deeply entrenched in the political military and diplomatic affairs of the young nation he held important administrative posts during the revolution two cabinet posts and served as a congressman senator and as a spokesman for the extremist element of new england s federalists clarfield presents the first comprehensive biography of pickering and a critical assessment of this controversial and often intractable man

george washington and the creation of the american republic debunks the portrayal of george washington in what is described by historians as the critical years 1781 1789 a time when he was deeply involved in land speculation western expansion scientific farming canal building political affairs and family matters directing the nation toward a strong central government

adventism and the american republic tells how their convictions led adventist adherents to become champions of religious liberty and the separation of church and state all in the interest of delaying the fulfillment of a prophecy that foresees the abolition of most freedoms through publication of liberty magazine lobbying of legislatures and pressing court cases adventists have been libertarian activists for more than a century and in recent times this stance has translated into strong resistance to the political agendas of christian conservatives drawing on adventist writings that have never been incorporated into a scholarly study morgan shows how the movement has struggled successfully to maintain its identifying beliefs with some modifications and how their sectarian exclusiveness and support of liberty has led to some tensions and inconsistencies book jacket

building the american republic tells the story of united states with remarkable grace and skill its fast moving narrative making the nation s struggles and accomplishments new and compelling weaving together stories of abroad range of americans volume 1 starts at sea and ends on the field beginning with the earliest americans and the arrival of strangers on the eastern shore it then moves through colonial society to the fight for independence and the construction of a federal republic vol 2 opens as america struggles to regain its footing reeling from a presidential assassination and facing massive economic growth rapid demographic change and combusive politics

in the transatlantic world of the late eighteenth century easterly winds blew radical thought to america thomas paine had already arrived on these shores in 1774 and made his mark as a radical pamphleteer during the revolution in his wake followed more than 200 other radical exiles english dissenters whigs and painites scottish lads o parts and irish patriots who became influential newspaper writers and editors and helped change the nature of political discourse in a young nation michael durey has written

the first full scale analysis of these radicals evaluating the long term influence their ideas have had on american political thought transatlantic radicals uncovers the roots of their radicalism in the old world and tells the story of how these men came to be exiled how they emigrated and how they participated in the politics of their adopted country nearly all of these radicals looked to paine as their spiritual leader and to thomas jefferson as their political champion they held egalitarian anti federalist values and promoted an extreme form of participatory democracy that found a niche in the radical wing of jefferson s republican party their divided views on slavery however reveal that democratic republicanism was unable to cope with the realities of that institution as political activists during the 1790s they proved crucial to jefferson s 1800 presidential victory then after his views moderated and their influence waned many repatriated others drifted into anonymity and a few managed to find success in the new world although many of these men are known to us through other histories their influence as a group has never before been so closely examined durey persuasively demonstrates that the intellectual ferment in britain did indeed have tremendous influence on american politics his account of that influence sheds considerable light on transatlantic political history and differences in religious political and economic freedoms skillfully balancing a large cast of characters transatlantic radicals depicts the diversity of their experiences and shows how crucial these reluctant émigrés were to shaping our republic in its formative years

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
