organized baseball has survived its share of difficult times and never was the state of the game more imperiled than during the great depression or was it remarkably during the economic upheavals of the depression none of the sixteen major league baseball teams folded or moved in this economist s look at the sport as a business between 1929 and 1941 david george surdam argues that although it was a very tough decade for baseball the downturn didn t happen immediately the 1930 season after the stock market crash had record attendance but by 1931 attendance began to fall rapidly plummeting 40 percent by 1933 to adjust teams reduced expenses by cutting coaches and hiring player managers while even the best players such as babe ruth were forced to take pay cuts most players
