the american revolution spurred the associational growth of the denomination reinforcing the rigid order of the authoritative master and subservient enslaved person given that the theme of liberty for all threatened slaveholders way of life in lowcountry south carolina in the 1790s where a white minority population lived in constant anxiety over control of the bodies of enslaved men and women news of revolt in st domingue haiti led to heightened fears of black violence fearful of being associated with antislavery evangelicals and in turn of being labeled as an enemy of the planter and urban elite white ministers orchestrated a major transformation in the baptist construction of paternalism forging a christian order provides a comprehensive examination of the baptist movement in south carolina from its founding to the eve of the civil war and reveals that the growth of the baptist church in south carolina paralleled the growth and institutionalization of the american system of slavery accommodating rather than challenging the prevailing social order of the economically stratified lowcountry
