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a magisterial book of nearly five hundred poems from some of history's greatest Chinese poets translated and edited by a renowned poet and scholar new republic the Chinese poetic tradition is the largest and longest continuous tradition in world literature this rich and far reaching anthology of nearly five hundred poems provides a comprehensive account of its first three millennia 1500 bce to 1200 ce the period during which virtually all its landmark developments took place unlike earlier anthologies of Chinese poetry Hinton's book focuses on a relatively small number of poets providing selections that are large enough to re-create each as a fully realized and unique voice new introductions to each poet's work provide a readable history told for the first time as a series of poetic innovations forged by a series of master poets David Hinton has lured into English a new manner of hearing the great poets of that long glory of China's classical age his achievement is another echo of the original and a gift to our language w s merwin

from Tottel's Miscellany 1557 to the last twentieth century Oxford Book of English Verse 1999 anthologies have been a prime institution for the preservation and mediation of poetry the importance of anthologies for creating and re-creating the canon of English poetry for introducing new programmes of poetry as a record of changing poetic fashions audience tastes and reading practices or as a profitable literary commodity has often been asserted despite its impact however the poetry anthology in itself has attracted surprisingly little critical interest in Britain or elsewhere in the English speaking world this volume is the first publication to explore the largely unmapped field of poetry anthologies in Britain essays written from a wide range of perspectives in literary and cultural studies and the point of view of poets editors publishers and cultural institutions aim to do justice to the typological functional and historical variety with which this form of publication has manifested itself from early modern print culture to the postmodern age of the world wide web

in best new african poets 2021 anthology there are 18 french speaking african poets from drc congo brazzaville cameroun ivory coast benin togo chad senegal comoros and more 14 portuguese speaking poets from angola sao tome and principe mozambique and 63 english speaking african poets from among other countries south africa nigeria zimbabwe kenya uganda malawi swaziland lesotho zambia tanzania ghana gambia sierra leone a full gamut of issues is dissected from love marriage relationships spirituality politics culture tradition environmentalism and the interstellar etc included are two collaborations the first deals with marriage juxtaposing monogamy vs polygamy with the 21th century lived experience the second imagines humanity living as intergalactic beings the poets were asked to be imaginative to be fictional poets to try to create and imagine human agency in this interstellar civilization approaching there is also featured 5 group interviews with 5 previous contributors to this series these interviews were interactive and collaborative with largely the bnap groups interviewing a poet critically engaging with their work and discussing the literary and social aspects the poetry addressed and lastly 4 reviews of african poetry

this book aims to gather a selection that represents the diversity and richness of american poetry written by poets who share a sophistication that promises to evolve with continued effort and risk a new and powerful poetic idiom

in this generous anthology joel conarroe has assembled the work of eight poets who have shaped and to some extent defined american verse since 1940 elizabeth bishop james merrill sylvia plath allen ginsberg theodore roethke john berryman anne sexton and robert lowell the 164 selections in eight american poets include widely anthologized works like roethke s my papa s waltz several of berryman s dream songs and anne sexton s ringing the bells as well as poems that are less familiar but just as haunting prefaced with a discerning introduction and individual biographical essays

the fifth edition retains the flexibility and breadth of selection that has defined this classic anthology while improved and expanded editorial apparatus make it an even more useful teaching tool

there s a marvelous revival of poetry underway in rutherford nj home of the influential american poet william carlos williams a symposium on williams has led to a poetry cooperative several websites two ongoing workshops and a monthly reading the rutherford red wheelbarrow poets anthology is the living proof of the great vortex of poetic energy that has been created the book features an unpublished poem by williams and also poets like john barrale celine beaulieu sondra singer beaulieu george de gregorio mark fogarty jim klein loren kleinman zorida mohammad deborah schantz claudia serea and many more
