thoughtful and tactful depictions or deficiencies books that are wrongheaded stereotypical or outdated each chapter has been significantly updated and this edition also includes new chapters on bisexual transgender and intersex issues and characters as well as chapters on comics graphic novels and works of nonfiction this book also features an annotated bibliography and a number of author title lists of books discussed in the text that will aid teachers librarians parents and teen readers encompassing a wider array of sexual identities representing the rainbow in young adult literature is an invaluable resource for young people eager to read about books relevant to them and their lives
