new material in a new format is contained in this third edition of family medicine the comprehensive text nevertheless remains true to the goal of previous editions in offering a scientific approach to health and illness within the context of the family using up to date clinical material the book demonstrates how the family physician may provide comprehensive health care to persons of all ages the first part of family medicine discusses such topics as the conceptual basis of family as discipline and specialty problem differentiation family centered health care longitudinal care clinical reasoning and resource management the second part explores both problems related to organs and systems and problems related to the person family and community including pregnancy care of infants children adolescents and the elderly behavioral and psychiatric problems emergency and critical care sports medicine alcoholism and substance misuse environmental health and neoplastic and infectious diseases family medicine with its greatly expanded in depth coverage of the most commonly encountered clinical core problems and procedures in family medicine continues to be a textbook written and edited by family physicians for family physicians

family medicine a practical approach shares essential tools for developing a successful practice and basic clinical methods and principles that will guide medical students residents general practitioners and certified family physicians through the daily routine of a family practitioner beginning with a thorough definition and history of family practice khalid s al gelban yahia m al

khaldi and mohammad m diab provide a comprehensive overview of a medical discipline where the family physician is a skilled clinician and the doctor patient relationship is central al gelban al khaldi and diab cover a broad range of topics that include medical ethics problem solving processes and key areas for action to improve health while teaching specific methods for diagnosing illness prescribing medicine and ensuring patient compliance medical professionals will also learn how to interview patients with specific symptoms and conduct physical examinations that will lead to accurate diagnoses and successful treatment plans from anxiety disorders to insomnia to hypertension family medicine a practical approach will lead medical professionals of all levels and experience through a discipline that is challenging rewarding and focused on providing excellent care to patients throughout the world

fundamentals of family medicine third edition describes the current approach to common problems in family practice the book tells how family physicians provide high quality comprehensive and ongoing health care for patients and families based on current evidence and time tested methods in clinical practice clinical scenarios that include case studies and questions for group discussion reinforce the book s clinical topics the clinical scenarios all concern members of the nelson family a multigenerational extended family whose members visit the family physician with a variety of health concerns and whose dynamics evolve from chapter to chapter the discussion questions allow the group to consider both the biomedical and psychosocial aspects of problems such as headache obstructive airway disease diabetes mellitus athletic injuries domestic violence care of the dying patient and the family physicians s role in dealing with terrorist events the book is intended to be a reference source for the care of diseases family physicians are likely to see and as the course textbook for medical students in family medicine clerkships in medical school this book will help health professionals provide up to date care for their patients and will allow students to view clinical issues through the eyes of the family physician fundamentals of family medicine third edition ideally is used as a companion to family medicine principles and practice sixth edition edited by robert b taylor et al

this is a greatly expanded successor to mcwhinney s an introduction to family medicine oxford 1978 it includes much new material on the nature of family medicine and on specific clinical problems there are two new chapters on the experience of illness suffering and healing and on doctor patient communication the chapter on the philosophical and scientific basis of family medicine has been expanded to do justice to the growing support which the paradigm of family medicine is receiving in the biological medical and social science literature the chapter on clinical method perhaps the book s core has a new look and greater depth reflecting work in this area over the past decade the chapter on prevention provides updated recommendations

and the chapter on the family has been enlarged the most noticeable change is the addition of five new chapters on common family practice problems these chapters have a dual purpose to exemplify the application of principles discussed earlier in the book and to distill the information on each problem that is most necessary for family physicians this is an ideal text for medical students taking a family medicine rotation and for beginning residents in the field

this new book explores the core values of family medicine nationally regionally and globally to identify if and or where there is consensus and where these diversify in relation to contextual factors aligned with the who s definition of primary healthcare and goal of universal health coverage and the united nations sustainable development goals the book documents a global enquiry by teams of experts representing each world region on the vision mission core values and principles and definition of family medicine in different countries each team has adopted different approaches and strategies in their exploration findings and conclusions a common identity for family doctors is important for research agendas training recognition of the specialty and advocacy however there is much diversity within and across the regions in the training and the practice of the discipline of family medicine reflected in the core values the ultimate goal is a shared vocabulary of humanity for colleagues throughout the world enriched rather than hindered by their differences key features addresses the core values and principles in family medicine and primary care across the globe built around the central elements of care that is patient centred equitable and community and science oriented with professionalism and cooperation as key themes supports primary care family medicine providers in their dual goals of caring for the whole person and adapting to the evolving needs of the population of people under their care tailored to reflect the specific needs in different world regions considers the challenges of fragmented care digital technologies comorbidities and growing health inequity accessible practical and international the book will be an invaluable guide for general practitioners family physicians family medicine specialists and other primary care doctors and a useful reference for other primary care health professionals including practice school and other primary care nurses medical assistants paramedics and community pharmacists it will also serve as recommended or supplementary reading in undergraduate medical and nursing programmes in university based postgraduate courses and master programmes in relevant primary care related topics and in vocational training programmes in general practice family medicine
