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this book which combines scholarly articles with interviews seeks to imagine a decolonized sociolinguistics all the chapters are firmly grounded

in southern approaches to knowledge production focusing not only on epistemology but also on the complex relationship between epistemology and ontology the chapters address issues ranging from author positionality to the central theorists of a southern sociolinguistics and roam from the language classroom to the church in ways which invite us to begin to decolonize ourselves and rethink normative assumptions about everything from academic writing to research methods and language teaching the book provides scholars and teachers with inspiration for how to teach linguistics in ways that challenge colonial hegemonies and that allow one to do sociolinguistics otherwise it also makes a powerful argument that debates about decolonization southern theory and social justice are not just academic pursuits what is at stake is our future and how we imagine it

an introduction to sociolinguistics the new eighth edition of an introduction to sociolinguistics brings this valuable bestselling textbook up to date with the latest in sociolinguistic research and pedagogy providing a broad overview of the study of language in social context with accessible coverage of major concepts theories methods issues and debates within the field this leading text helps students develop a critical perspective on language in society as they explore the complex connections between societal norms and language use the eighth edition contains new and updated coverage of such topics as the societal aspects of african american vernacular english aave multilingual societies and discourse gender and sexuality ideologies and language attitudes and the social meanings of linguistic forms organized in four sections this text first covers traditional language issues such as the distinction between languages and dialects identification of regional and social variation within languages and the role of context in language use and interpretation subsequent chapters cover approaches to research in sociolinguistics variationist sociolinguistics ethnography and discourse analytic research and address both macro and micro sociolinguistic aspects of multilingualism in national transnational global and digital contexts the concluding section of the text looks at language in relation to gender and sexuality education and language planning and policy issues featuring examples from a variety of languages and cultures that illustrate topics such as social and regional dialects multilingualism and the linguistic construction of identity this text provides perspectives on both new and foundational research in sociolinguistics and linguistic anthropology an introduction to sociolinguistics eighth edition remains the ideal textbook for upper level undergraduate and graduate course in sociolinguistics language and society linguistic anthropology applied and theoretical linguistics and education the new edition has also been updated to support classroom application with a range of effective

pedagogical tools including end of chapter written exercises and an instructor website as well as materials to support further learning such as reading suggestions research ideas and an updated companion student website containing a searchable glossary a review guide additional exercises and examples and links to online resources

the romance languages offer a particularly fertile ground for the exploration of the relationship between language and society in different social contexts and communities focusing on a wide range of romance languages from national languages to minoritised varieties this volume explores questions concerning linguistic diversity and multilingualism language contact medium and genre variation and change it will interest researchers and policy makers alike

cognitive sociolinguistics draws on the rich theoretical framework of cognitive linguistics and focuses on the social factors that underlie the variability of meaning and conceptualization in the last decade the field has expanded in various way the current volume takes stock of current and emerging advances in the field in short academic contributions the studies collected in this book have a usage based approach to language variation and change drawing on the theoretical framework of cognitive linguistics and are sensitive to social variation be it cross linguistic or language internal three types of contributions are collected in this book first it contains theoretical overview papers on the domains that have witnessed expansion in recent years second it presents novel research ideas in proof of concept contributions aimed at blue sky research and out of the box linguistic analyses third it showcases recent empirical studies within the field by combining these three types of contributions the book provides an encompassing overview of novel developments in the field of cognitive sociolinguistics

brings the study of writing to the heart of sociolinguistic inquiry this book puts writing at the centre of sociolinguistic inquiry drawing on a range of academic fields including new literacy studies semiotics genre studies stylistics and new rhetoric the key question the book explores is what do we mean by writing in the 21 century using examples from across a range of contexts the book argues that writing involving both old and new technologies is a pervasive and complex communicative feature of contemporary life the book is organised around the following areas the multimodal nature of writing the verbal dimension to writing writing as everyday practice writing as a differentiated semiotic and social resource writing as the inscription of identity a range of analytic tools for analysing

writing as text and practice are illustrated including genre register discourse and metaphor as well as notions which emphasise the mobile potential of writing such as genre chains networks literacy brokers and text trajectories this book seeks to redress the neglect of writing in the field of sociolinguistics by introducing readers to the nature and consequences of what it means to do writing in a globalised world

this volume is the first comprehensive survey of the sociolinguistic studies on japanese like other languages has developed a highly diverse linguistic system that is realized as variation shaped by interactions of linguistic and social factors this volume primarily focuses on both classic and current topics of sociolinguistics that were first studied in western languages and then subsequently examined in the japanese language the topics in this volume cover major issues in sociolinguistics that also characterize sociolinguistic features of japanese such topics as gender honorifics and politeness are particularly pertinent to japanese as is well known in general sociolinguistics at the same time this volume includes studies on other topics such as social stratification discourse contact and language policy which have been widely conducted in the japanese context in addition this volume introduces domestic approaches to sociolinguistics developed in japan they emerged a few decades before the development of the so called labovian and hymesian sociolinguistics in the us and they have shaped a unique development of sociolinguistic studies in japan

language has established itself as an academic subject in many countries
the discipline promises to be of benefit in solving practical problems in such
areas as language planning and standardization language teaching and
therapy and language policy both research projects and publications and
university teaching programmes in sociolinguistics now span such a wide
field that it is hardly possible even for the experts to review the whole
scope of the subject a number of specialist periodicals and introductions
and sur

society in which speakers live almost since the beginning of the discipline
however attempts have been made to extrapolate backwards and interpret
past linguistic change sociolinguistically some of these findings have

application of sociolinguistic theory and findings has rarely been attempted
however despite the specialist literature which demonstrates this
connection at specific points in the language s development this textbook

understanding of the sociolinguistic forces which initiate or encourage
language change uniquely it discusses not only the central variationist
tendencies present in language change and their analysis but also the
macrosociolinguistic forces which act upon all speakers and their language
chapters investigate the political cultural and economic forces which affect
a society s use of and views on language language contact language
standardisation and linguistic attrition are also covered discussion is
illustrated throughout by apposite examples from the history of english the
volume enables students to develop a deeper understanding of both

this book demonstrates the power and distinctiveness of the contribution that sociolinguistics can make to our understanding of everyday communicative practice under changing social conditions it builds on the approaches developed by gumperz and hymes in the 1970s and 80s and it not only affirms their continuing relevance in analyses of the micropolitics of everyday talk in urban settings but also argues for their value in emergent efforts to chart the heavily securitised environments now developing around us drawing on 10 years of collaborative work and ranging across disciplinary interdisciplinary and applied perspectives the book begins with guiding principles and methodology shifts to empirically driven arguments in urban sociolinguistics and concludes with studies of in securitised communication addressed to challenges ahead

this book examines the complexity of chineseness in china and the chinese diaspora using critical sociolinguistic and discourse analytical approaches the chapters reveal the power dynamics and ideologies underlying the varied ways chineseness is performed represented and contested together they highlight four perspectives on chineseness the multiplicity of chineseness aspirational chineseness chronotopes of chineseness and the cultural politics of chineseness it is argued that chineseness is best understood as an ideologically constructed variable the articulation of which is deeply embedded within the dynamics of neoliberal globalization rising nationalism persistent western hegemony and shifting global geopolitics

this book explores the ways in which language is understood in diverse contexts and how linguistic theories and the idea of language as an object fail to represent a reality that is inherently multi and trans the chapters tease out the way that an understanding of language as a social practice and the central role of the speaker s and their repertoire allows for a more nuanced interpretation of language in contexts ranging from english as an international neutral language in research and teaching to the importance of life trajectories and multilingualism in the development of theoretical perspectives the book offers a glimpse of a decolonial linguistics that recognizes the importance of entanglement between languages between the north and south and between the personal and the theoretical

this volume seeks to extend and expand our current understanding of the processes of language standardization drawing on both quantitative and qualitative approaches to examine how linguistic variation plays out in various ways in everyday life in denmark the book compares linguistic variation across three different rural speech communities underpinned by a transversal framework which draws upon different methodological and analytical approaches as well as data from different contexts across different generations and results in a nuanced and dynamic portrait of language change in one region over time examining communities with varying degrees of linguistic variation with this multi layered framework demonstrates a broader need to re examine perceptions of language standardization as a unidirectional process but rather as one shaped by a range of factors at the local level including language ideologies and mediatization a concluding chapter by eminent sociolinguist david britain brings together the conclusions drawn from the preceding chapters and reinforces their wider implications within the field of sociolinguistics offering new insights into language standardization and language change this book will be of particular interest to students and scholars in sociolinguistics dialectology and linguistic anthropology
