southern france and explores the teal skies emerald hills red soil and indigo seas beloved by the artist the journey begins in paris and then moves to the fashionable port of st tropez the fishing village of collioure chic and voluptuous nice and the rustic refuge of vence and ends in the luxurious resort of cimiez the author identifies the villas and studios where matisse lived and worked in each location and discusses how his art responded to the palette and ambience of each local landscape

starting just east of la ciutat the great sweep of mediterranean coast all the way to the italian border is referred to as the cote d azur or the riviera it is a large area with dozens of beaches and despite the coast s reputation for toney glamor alternating with brash vulgarity it s a great location for watersports boating parasailing climbing hiking and gliding the western cote d azur is a deeply indented coast characterized by many small towns miles of sandy beaches and three great mountainous headlands called massifs the massif des maures massif de l esterel and massif de tanneron foreshadow the march of the alps to the sea farther east along the riviera they offer stunning long distance views and provide miles of good walking for years french vacationers kept the region their secret staying in their holiday homes or with friends and family as a result the massifs remain largely undiscovered territory for foreign visitors who usually race around and between them on motorways heading for the coast if you stop to enjoy this region you ll find it has its own personality and surprises among the attractions here are st tropez and st raphael like a lot of people i got my first glimpse of the riviera watching classic movies on television cary grant and grace kelly trading barbs on a balcony overlooking a yacht filled harbor in to catch a thief one of any number of james bonds or simon templars stepping out of the casino at monte carlo pink panther movies car chases on the grande corniche david niven in casino royale they all created an indelible impression of a gorgeous glamorous and expensive jetsetters paradise the term jetsetter is a little dusty these days but substitute eurotrash and the idea is the same celebrities minor royals and fashionistas mingling with arms dealers deposed dictators media tycoons and shipping magnates while gossip columnists write about their lifestyles of apparently endless leisure this is not an entirely imaginary picture there s no denying that the riviera is a playground for the rich and famous behind the walls and towering hedges of cap ferrat and other such places most of what all the money in the world will buy can probably be found but don t be put off if you re traveling on a modest budget it is the glamor of the landscape and all the outdoor activities to which it lends itself that was probably what attracted the beautiful

people in the first place and that is within reach of everyone breathtaking drives along les corniches de la riviera and coastal walks that range from gentle strolls to challenging climbs are laced between the distinctive towns and villages antibes nice menton beaulieu sur mer villefranche scattered almost artfully along the coast in the skies paragliders float down like flower petals from a handful of exceptional launch sites starting around antibes and heading east the back country rises and the alps crowd down to the water along the way the villages perchees become ever more dramatic eze at 427 m 1 400 feet tops a narrow dome of rock la turbie at 500 m 1 640 feet is where the emperor augustus planted the trophée des alpes a 165 foot monument to the power of rome that still lords over the coast and looks down on monte carlo the medieval village of sainte agnes just inland of menton at 800 m 2 600 feet claiming to be the highest coastal village in europe this is an excerpt equivalent to about 200 print pages from the 420 page adventure guide to provence the cote d azur both books are highly detailed exploring the culture the sights and activities the places to stay and the best restaurants dozens of photographs are included plus 15 detailed maps

the time around 1910 has entered art history as the moment when abstraction was invented however where and when works of non figurative art became present in the public eye has been afforded little attention to date exhibiting abstraction is the first publication to be devoted entirely to the presentation of abstract art between 1908 and 1915 it uncovers strategies for the dissemination of early abstract painting in exhibitions with the aid of a register of exhibited works by giacomo balla umberto boccioni wassily kandinsky frantisek kupka kazimir malevich piet mondrian and francis picabia shown to the public within this period and an analysis of the artists exhibition activities the key role played by art exhibitions in the works introduction and dissemination is highlighted

chronicling two hundred years of glamour intrigue and hedonism this rich and vivid history of the french riviera features a vast cast of characters from pablo picasso and coco chanel to andre matisse and james baldwin 1835 lord brougham founded cannes introducing bathing and the manicured lawn to the wilds of the mediterranean coast today much of that shore has become a concrete mass from which escape is an exclusive dream in the 185 years between the stretch of seaboard from the red mountains of the esterel to the italian border hosted a cultural phenomenon well in excess of its tiny size a mere handful of towns and resorts created by foreign visitors notably english russian and american attracted the talented rich and famous as well as those who wanted to be for nearly two centuries of creativity luxury excess scandal war and corruption the dark and sparkling world of the riviera was a temptation for everybody who was anybody often frivolous it was also a potent cultural matrix that inspired the likes of picasso matisse coco chanel scott fitzgerald cole porter james baldwin catherine mansfield sartre and stravinsky in once upon a time world jonathan miles presents the remarkable story of the small strip of french coast that lured the world to its shores it is a wild and unforgettable tale that follows the riviera s transformation from paradise and wilderness to a pollution imperiled concrete jungle

the novel leroy is the story of a young african american of the same name raised and educated in france his parents are both african americans his mother is an international civil servant with unesco and his father is a successful cabaret owner in paris the novel opened in the main square of saint tropez france where leroy is convinced that his neighbor eric has just made a homosexual overtures towards his adolescent son leroy overcomes reticence to make a scene and a fear that as a black he is helpless to provide protection even for his son this leads to flashbacks

in which Leroy family life and his education in France are reviewed. Leroy was raised in an upper class neighborhood of Paris and attended schools frequented by privileged children. He acquired refined manners plus a superior cultural education that contrasted with that of his parents. This led to problems of identity that are treated in the novel. Leroy received an excellent higher education and married a beautiful French woman with a similar educational background who came from a family with a left winged political history. With the help of his father, brother, son, and wife, he became a successful businessman and mayor of a large French city. Yet he is haunted by the fear that his offspring will be intellectually inferior because of their race. He is greatly influenced by the book *The Bell Shaped Curve*, and much of the novel are reactions, not necessarily negative, to assertions made in the work. As Leroy moves up politically and financially, nevertheless, he discovers racism in France unlike that which his parents knew in the United States. Because he doubts his hereditary intelligence, he compensates by untiring hard work. He works very hard on his job and coped successfully with the problem of certain potential customers being reticent to deal with blacks. He surmounts all difficulties, shrewdly purchases stock options in the firm for which he works from fellow employees, and eventually finds himself in reaching distance of acquiring a controlling interest. Eventually, he gains control of the French company where he suffered racial prejudice with the help of the mysterious Swinborn Foundation, a non governmental organization whose manifest goal is to assist the United States government with matters it approves but are too delicate for direct involvement. At Leroy's father's request, the Swinborn Foundation takes charge of making Leroy an important political figure in France. There are two subplots. The first concerns Leroy's 14 year old son, Gaetan, who is putatively sexually abused by Eric, a 40 year old French scholar. Eric is arrested and discovers that his fate strongly depends on what will be most favorable for Leroy's political ambitions. Gaetan is a particularly mature and brilliant young man who cooperates with agents of the Swinborn Foundation to best exploit his relationship with Eric in order to help his father's political aspirations. The second subplot involves Leroy's father, Johnny, and his contribution to the breaking up of the Soviet Union. Johnny was a front man for a CIA operation to purchase various Soviet arms for use by forces fighting against the Soviet occupation of Afghanistan. A surface to air missile that passed through Johnny's hands was used to shoot down an American airplane. This led to Johnny's incarceration, which had a negative effect on his son's political aspirations, followed by very positive effects when friends of the CIA cleared him and tried to compensate him for his inconvenience by helping his son with his political and business career in France. Leroy's struggle is not only to succeed but also to belong, to be accepted by society. His feeling of non acceptance

is manifest by his feeling that he does not have a single close friend either among frenchmen or in the african american community in france

inspired by monet s work at a young age paul signac 1863 1935 was a friend and disciple of georges seurat who combined the scientific precision of pointillism with the vivid colors and emotional expressivity of impressionism a close personal friend of vincent van gogh who was a great admirer of his techniques signac traveled the world in search of inspiration for his monumental canvases this book examines the intricacies of signac s celebrated technique as well as showcasing the details of some of his most celebrated works

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
