the main objective of the book is to allocate the grass roots initiatives of remembering the holocaust victims in a particular region of russia which has a very diverse ethnic structure and little presence of jews at the same time it aims to find out how such individual initiatives correspond to the official russian hero orientated concept of remembering the second world war with almost no attention to the memory of war victims including holocaust victims north caucasus became the last address of thousands of soviet jews both evacuees and locals while there was almost no attention paid to the holocaust victims in the official soviet propaganda in the postwar period local activists and historians together with the members of jewish communities preserved holocaust memory by installing small obelisks at the killing sites writing novels and making documentaries teaching about the holocaust at schools and making small thematic exhibitions in the local and school museums individual types of grass roots activities in the region on remembering holocaust victims are analyzed in each chapter of the book

a must read book that explores a vital pre war effort with deep research and gripping writing washington times in the rise of the g i army 1940 1941 paul dickson tells the dramatic story of how the american army was mobilized from scattered outposts two years before pearl harbor into the disciplined and mobile fighting force that helped win world war ii in september 1939 when nazi germany invaded poland and initiated world war ii america had strong isolationist leanings the us army stood at fewer than 200 000 men unprepared to defend the country much less carry the fight to europe and the far east and yet less than a year after pearl harbor the american army led the allied invasion of north africa beginning the campaign that would defeat germany and the navy and marines were fully engaged with japan in the pacific dickson chronicles this transformation from franklin roosevelt s selection of george c marshall to be army chief of staff to the remarkable peace time draft of 1940 and the massive and unprecedented mock battles in tennessee louisiana and the carolinas by which the skill and spirit of the army were forged and out of which iconic leaders like eisenhower bradley and clark emerged the narrative unfolds against a backdrop of political and cultural isolationist resistance and racial tension at home and the increasingly perceived threat of
