freedom and iraqi freedom with this analysis of their vehicles tracing the evolution of the vehicle types from their historical precedents through their designs to their operational developments he discusses their advantages and disadvantages along with their tactical employment from the mine protected vehicles used to counter the ied threat in iraq the use of strykers as armoured raiding platforms by the us rangers to the civilian vehicles adapted for military service by both coalition troops and private military contractors in the regions this book uses rare in theatre photographs and colour artwork to show the variety and inventiveness of the patrol vehicles being used in combat

the first in depth book that sheds light on canada s elite warriors who operate in the shadows in 2001 the canadian government sent elements of its joint task force 2 counterterrorist unit to afghanistan to assist the americans with operation enduring freedom and the global war on terror withdrawn a year later after a brief hiatus jtf 2 returned to afghanistan in 2005 beginning a continuous tour of duty for canadian special operation forces cansof up to the cessation of canadian combat operations in 2011 this book reveals six untold special operations that cansof personnel undertook in their desperate struggle in the shadows to capture or kill taliban leaders facilitators and bomb makers as well as efforts to mentor afghan national security forces from 2005 to 2011 the missions highlight that the nation s sof were no ordinary men

this book tells the story of task force ranger a unit of us rangers and special forces and their attempt to capture the lieutenants of the somali warlord muhamed farrah aideed during the 1993 united nations humanitarian relief mission what started as a simple snatch and grab mission quickly degenerated into a desperate battle for survival when us black hawk helicopters were struck by rocket propelled grenades and crashed into the streets of mogadishu racing to save the crew task force ranger was surrounded by mobs of hostile somali gunmen the battle in the city raged all night as the better equipped and better trained us forces kept the nearly overwhelming numbers of somalis at bay finally battered bloodied and low on ammunition the task force was rescued by a combined un and us relief force and extracted to safety containing detailed maps and declassified information this is a dramatic retelling of a brutal battle that had a far reaching impact on us military policy

russia s february 2022 invasion of ukraine triggered the bloodiest war in europe since world war ii and raised significant questions about the united states role in europe this csis report examines the u s force posture in europe including the military capabilities personnel infrastructure and agreements that support defense operations and plans and makes recommendations for future u s posture it finds that the united states needs a robust long term military force posture in europe focused on the north atlantic treaty organization s nato eastern flank to deter future russian aggression

vice adm william h mcraeven helped to devise the strategy for how to bring down osama bin laden and commanded the courageous u s military unit that carried it out on may 1 2011 ending one of the greatest manhunts in history in spec ops a well organized and deeply researched study mcraeven analyzes eight classic special operations six are from wwii the german commando raid on the belgian fort eben emael 1940 the italian torpedo attack on the alexandria harbor 1941 the british commando raid on nazaire france 1942 the german glider rescue of benito mussolini 1943 the british midget submarine attack on the tirpitz 1943 and the u s ranger rescue mission at the cabanatuan pow camp in the philippines 1945 the two post wwii examples are the u s army raid on the son tay pow camp in north vietnam 1970 and the israeli rescue of the skyjacked hostages in entebbe uganda 1976 mcraeven who commands a u s navy seal team pinpoints six essential principles of spec ops success simplicity security repetition surprise speed and purpose for each of the case studies he provides political and military context a meticulous reconstruction of the mission itself and an analysis of the operation in relation to his six principles mcraeven deems the son tay raid the best modern example of a successful spec op which should be considered textbook material for future missions his own book is an instructive textbook that will be closely studied by students of the military arts maps photos
