bert tieben is very well read in the history of economic thought and provides an overview of one of the basic concepts of economics that is unrivalled both in its scope and in its thoughtful and detailed discussion of the various currents and schools it goes right to the heart of economic theory and asks some pertinent questions about the limits and the future of economic theorizing that is i think what sets it apart
